spiritual help and counseling. The Lord has given me various topics that have impacted many. The radio has an audience in the west of the country and many who are in hospitals listen to this radio station. I hope to continue with this ministry in the coming year.

We have continued helping in the communities with the most need. This has been a great blessing to my personal life. With the help of the church we have collected and handed out clothes and food. With the support of my friends, I have been able to dedicate more time to these communities in the mountains. The families with the most need in El Paste have received a little relief from all their needs. Thank you for always asking about the people from this community.

I am sure that each prayer sent to Heaven on my behalf and on the ministry here has reached the Throne of Grace. Your prayers have helped me move forward. I am truly grateful for your support. I have seen the favor of the Lord in my life. And you have encouraged me through your encouragements. I will not deny that there have been times of discouragement, but the Lord has sustained me. I am trusting in the Lord that next year He will bring a fresh vision so I can continue in His work and reach even more for His Kingdom. I want to finish the work we have before us and I trust we will enjoy His presence together, some day.

As I thank you for everything you have done for me, I also remember you in my prayers. I pray each will be prospered in everything and that your soul will be encouraged. It is my prayer that the Lord will grant you the requests of your heart. That in this Christmas season will be a great blessing for you and for your families.
