Dear brothers and sisters,

We want to thank you.  
Thank you for your prayers  
and financial help.

This year began with great challenges for us. Unfortunately, two of our social outreach ministries will have to be closed: the birth care center and the medical clinic. We are closing these two ministries for a time due to the fact that the doctor attending the medical clinic left the country to study a specialty and the midwife now lives in another village far from Balibrea. We are saddened by this and ask for your prayers. In order to cover these needs to some degree, we are using our own car to transport the women who are about to give birth and the ill to the medical clinics in the cities nearby. For that we ask your prayers.

But the other ministries continue such as: *The Children's Nutrition Center, The Scholarship Program, visiting the sick, Bible Studies in the schools, Evangelization and Leadership Training.*

## Nutrition center

In the children's nutrition center we have provision for food through the month of August. We are providing two meals a week for 25 boys and girls. We ask that you pray that God will provide for the months after August.

## Scholarships

In the school scholarship ministry we have been helping more than 200 children for more than 10 years. But each year we have less help for the boys and girls. This year we may be able to help 100 children or maybe a few more. Each child needs \$40 a year to be able to study. We ask for your prayers so that in November of every year we can have the money needed to help these children. This is because the school year in Honduras goes from February to November.

## Other ministries

We are training local leaders so that they can work in evangelization and work with new groups in which new churches will be planted in the future. In Balibrea, our brother Kevin Hernandez is now pastor. We ask for your prayers for provision since he is leaving his other job to work full time in the pastorate.

The Sunday School is growing little by little and that is presenting new challenges. Our building is not yet finished and we need to improve the classrooms. They need new walls, doors and windows. We hold a few classes outside and we have problems when it rains or is cold. We ask for your prayers that God would provide for the finishing of our classrooms.

We would like to have an evangelism team from the church for the new places we hope to plant new churches, as well as Vacation Bible School in the public schools in the different places we are working. We would like to have construction teams to help improve the facilities in Balibrea.

We would ask for your prayers for:

1. Protection and health for Noel and Reina.
2. The political situation in Honduras.
3. That God would provide economically for Noely's studies since they are very expensive.
4. A job for Daniel.
