1. In regards to the growth and expansion of the church, we give thanks to God for some leaders who are willing to work hard in the church in Balibrea. I ask for your prayers for these leaders.
2. Additionally, thanks to the growth of the church in Balibrea and the work that these new leaders are doing, we have been able to go and make contact with another village and leaders who are interested in planting a new church. The village is called *Agua Salada*, or Salt Water in English. There we will be developing a plan to plant a new church. We have made contact with a leader who is willing to work in that place, moreover he is already working in that community. I ask you for your prayers for this new church planting project.

4. continues with the good news that we have increased to 30 children who are signed up to receive this food aid. Although, with the little brother or neighbor who tags along sometimes we have between 35 and 40.

I ask for your prayers for our sister in Christ, Sandra Hernandez, who is in charge of preparing and serving the food.

We give thanks to God since we have heard from the teachers from the public school that the children from the feeding program have improved in their studies.

5. School scholarships: We give thanks to God for this beautiful ministry in which we still have 250 scholarship children. Last year we saw the first girl graduate from high school. This year we will have one more who will graduate high school with an emphasis in business administration.
6. Center for ministry training: As most of you know, one of my tasks as a missionary is the training of leaders and pastors. As such, one of the goals we have in Balibrea is to build an educational center to which we can bring leaders and pastors from the villages and local churches to receive training. For this purpose we have designated some of the sections of the building in Balibrea, sections which have yet to be built. For this reason we ask for your prayers that God will provide the funds to build this building.
7. Reasons to pray:
 - a. We pray for protection for Noely in the capitol.
 - b. We pray for the different ministries in Balibrea and the Christian Family Center.
 - c. We pray that God will provide the funds to finish the building in Balibrea and for the construction of the building for the Center for Ministry Training for pastors and church leaders.
 - d. We pray for the new village where we will be collaborating on a new church plant.
 - e. We pray for the social and political situation in Honduras.
