Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It is a blessing to write to you and share with you some experiences we have had on the mission field.

First, we want to thank God that He allowed my wife and I to travel to the United States last October. We were able to visit with friends and churches and we shared about our ministry here in Honduras.

We also want to thank each of you who received us in your homes during that time. May God bless you. We returned to Honduras full of hope. We know that you are praying for us and are a part of our ministry.

Upon returning to Honduras we were able to finish out the year well. With much work we have felt a little under the weather but we are also overjoyed to know that God has kept us in His work for another year.

This new year we have begun our ministry full of energy and with joy that only God can give. The Lord has provided through good friends to begin the construction of the roof at the area where we play soccer. The plan is that in the future it will be a multi-purpose area. Also we will be improving the first level at Balibrea. Here will we have a center to train pastors, leaders and future pastors for the churches. I ask that you would be in prayer for all of these activities. I also ask that you would pray for us as we want to build up the second level of the building in Balibrea. This will be used to have a center for education. We hope to provide the community with 7th, 8th and 9th grade education. As you may or may not know, public education stops at 6th grade. We pray God would provide the funding for this.

We are excited to share with you that the center for child nutrition continues with 32 children. We feed them twice a week. Please continue to be in prayer for this ministry.

We also have been able to hand out the scholarships for the 2019 school year. God is faithful.

The church in Balibrea continues to grow. We have two services during the week. On Sunday we have a Sunday School class and on Tuesday we have a Bible study and prayer meeting. Brother Yovany and his family continue to serve in Balibrea. Yovany is the pastor there. I ask you pray for him, that the Lord would provide the financial support he needs for his family.

We are also working in the community of Agua Salada. Brother Santana and his family are planting a new church, and we thank God that the group is growing. God has provided some property to build a church building. Please pray with me that God would provide the money to build the church building as well as the Sunday school classes. Agua Salada is a community north east of Siguatepeque. It has a population of about 600 people. There is no electricity, no running water. The hygiene is not good in that area, and we would like to help build some facilities.
