Brothers, we send you a big hug and greetings in Christ.

We would like to share with you in this letter what God is doing not only in our lives in the ministry but also in our family and personally.



As for the ministry, we traveled to northern Peru for a week long evangelistic campaign. Something good about this trip was that not only young people participated but also teens and adults formed our good-sized group of 23 people. We offered medical help and presented the Gospel with dramatic

presentations, as well as entering into public schools in an area called LAS CUEVAS. We also offered counseling. Later, we ministered in an area close to the city of CHULUCANAS, where once again we presented the Gospel through dramatic presentations, as well as offering medical help the next day.



Without a doubt, it was a satisfying trip, not only because we were able to complete our purpose of presenting the Gospel, but also being able to encourage

the people we traveled with and motivate the two churches we worked with to continue on. We were thankful for the good attendance of unbelievers who were able to hear the Word of God.



After arriving home, our church had a 2-day Awards Camp the following week for the children from our kids club who have had the most noted participation so far this year.



The second day was quite satisfying as we had a recreational outing where together with the kids we went with we were able to present the Gospel to strangers on the bus and at the park.

These things have been a blessing for us and we believe that they will be for you too.



As for us, brothers, we continue with our regular activities, daily teaching at school, with the youth on Saturdays and on Wednesdays we go out with a group of them to do door-to-door evangelism. The purpose of going out on Wednesdays is not just for us to evangelize but to form within the younger generation this vision. We are very interested in investing in them as we have been for

some years now as the next generation of leaders that one day will replace us. We believe that it is our job to train up leaders that love God, honor his word, and will pass it along to the following generation.

It is our delight to share with you that Evelyng is pregnant. I am feeling calmer now as she is 4 months along and the threat of losing the baby has progressively



declined, for which we are quite content. This was not as true at the beginning of the pregnancy, as we shared with you in previous letters, last year she had a miscarriage, and we couldn't help but think it might happen again. However, God in his grace gave us this new possibility. Our son David is very excited and anticipating the arrival of this new member of our family, who is due the first weeks of January. We would ask you to pray that all goes well according to the good hand of our God.



Brothers, I would also like to share with you some of the plans and challenges that our pastor and director have presented to me regarding new ministry responsibilities. With all sincerity, I want to be very careful in doing this. My wife and I are praying for this. It has been almost seven years that these plans have been in the works.
