Huyhua Family Update

Dear Brothers,

Once again we write you to inform you and thank you for all the help that you give us.

Youth: It is a pleasure to be able to share with you and at the same time a joy that God is at work in our ministry. We are seeing the people that we are working with grow, mature, and take on greater responsibilities. This teaches us that we are not indispensable but we rejoice in seeing the next generation now becoming a reality. We thank God for these young people.

Some of them are beginning to form their own families. We had a wedding the end of November, and we are anticipating three more weddings from our church in the near future. We see how these soon-to-be married couples are getting involved serving and how God, himself, is guiding them to continue the work in our church.

<u>Cell Group</u>: In the cell group we continue to work with families. Three new families have begun to participate in our group that meets each Friday and they have continued to come. Some of them arrived with serious problems; nevertheless, God is working out his purpose in them. This is a tremendous reason to

give thanks to our God. The gospel has reached them and now they are not only coming to cell group but to church as well.



Evangelism: This is a task that we are

doing with a group of men and youth from the church, every Wednesday. Our goal is to visit three specific places in order to evangelize these neighborhoods, but also to have contact with the parents whose children participate in the kids' Bible club on Saturdays at our church. As a result, some of them have made a decision for Christ and others still have not, yet they are open to us visiting them and continuing to work with their children. This focus seems to be working well as we are able to build trust with them, not only speaking with them about the Lord Jesus, but also getting involved in their lives. As we mentioned, we are doing this in three neighborhoods: Nueva Esperanza, Las Casitas, and 14 de Febrero.

These outings have allowed us not only the opportunity to establish contacts with the parents but also carry out the Great Commission. The five young guys and other married men with whom we go out are not only being motivated to evangelize but also trained to continue doing it. I thank God as He is the one that put this desire and burden in the hearts of these men to go out and share about Christ. We are slowly working on this task, in all sincerity, we are not rushing to cover these neighborhoods and as a consequence we are seeing results.

Family: As for Evelyng and our future son, we are now in the last stage as she is just about to 8 months and we are anticipating the birth of Natán, Lord-willing, the 11th of January. We ask for your prayers brothers. This pregnancy has been very different from her pregnancy with David, but the doctor says that everything is going well and looks normal. Currently, we are trying to prepare another room for the baby and set up some things in David's room as well, before Natán's arrival.

We would also like to share with you that David is finishing up Kindergarten this month, and next year will be in elementary school. How time flies! yet we thank God that he is graduating and it is a great joy for him. In addition, he turned 6 years old the last week of November.

Brothers, thank you and thank you again for your support through prayers and offerings. As I have shared with you before, we feel in debt to God by means of you for your help and we commit ourselves even more to continue serving our God and his kingdom.

Please pray that all will go well with the baby's delivery, for Evelyng's recovery, and for me, as the baby is set to arrive when we are in the middle of summer camps and mission teams visiting. I am trying to figure out in my head how it will all work, but God is teaching me in this as well.
