We wish to share with you what God has been doing in our lives. Beyond a doubt, it is a pleasure to do so, and we give many thanks for His work in us.



**Young Adults:** this is the perfect month to share with you that one of the young men in our church, Luis Diaz, with whom God has allowed us to work and influence his life, is getting married this Friday to a young lady from our church. Both serve the Lord in the youth ministry and both are teachers in La Roca Christian School. Not only that, but both have strong testimonies and good hearts, and we would ask your prayers that God would provide for their needs during

this blessed time.

**Cell Group:** God continues allowing us to share each Friday with small groups from our church in the homes of two families, the Zorilla Family and the Muro Family. The group has grown in number and also in their interest in the Word of God. They are faithful in their attendance and their service, and we give thanks to God for the group.

The purpose of the cell groups is to spend time together in prayer and fellowship. Since the growth of the church on Sundays makes fellowship difficult, we come together on Friday nights to study the Word of God and share our needs and struggles before God.

**Evangelism:** each Wednesday we go out to share the Gospel with the men, both young and "older," from the church. 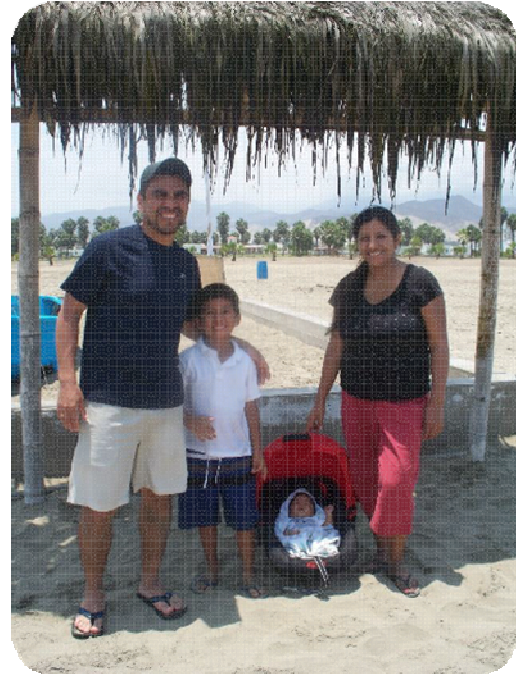
