Beloved brothers, we want to thank you once again for allowing us to share with you our lives, both in ministry and family:

This is, without a doubt, a very different year, since our home life has changed and been enriched with the arrival of our second son, Nathan. God

in His grace has allowed us to grow in our lives, so we share with you a little of what God is doing in us:

Cell Group: The cell group we have each Friday has grown in number of families, and attend church they regularly. At least four new families are attending and this regularly. is



reason to give thanks to God for His saving work. In the church we are discipling some of then and their children, which is a great priviledge. To tell the truth, we've had more discipleship than we can handle, but always within what God allows. Evelyng has also little by little resumed this labor, which she left for a time because of the baby. It is heartwarming to see the



slow but sure results of people who are understanding the step of Faith they have taken, and our prayer is that the cell group would plant and water the Word of God and give these families a strong foundation in Scripture, knowing that God is the one who gives growth.



Youth: in the church we have three groups we consider youth, each of which meets separately: teens (between 30 and 40 teens), young adults (about 20), and singles or college and career (about 17 of them). We are training and teaching them as our future church leadership. We used to have more of

the college and career group, but they keep getting married on us, and now many of them are forming their own families. What a blessing to see these brothers growing with us. Just this Saturday we had another wedding, in addition to the 5 we've already had this year! We love to see how God has been uniting couples into families and giving testimony to their families through them, so that they, too, might know the Lord. Many of our new couples are involved in serving the Lord, and we pray that God would make of them strong families, and above all that they would be grounded in the principles of his Word and be a testimony to society...and that God would continue joining young adults in holiness in Christ, this is no longer normal

in Peru, and not even in many churches.

We also had many evangelistic outings with a school from the USA that visited us and stayed at the La Roca campus as part of their high school graduation. We went out with them to do open air evangelism (evangelism by means of sports and games) so we involved and shared the



Gospel with children, youth, and parents who attended these activities over the course of 5 days in different areas.



TriptotheYouthConferenceinMedellin Colombia:

I have been travelling to Colombia to teach in a youth conference in the city of Medellin, and the truth is it was a good and satisfying time. This conference is on a national level and basically with church leaders, so we were sharing themes related to

leadership. It was exhausting, since we gave three classes per day, but it was gratifying to be used by God's grace to build up and encourage, even though in all sincerety by the end I received more blessing than I think I gave.

Of course I missed my family terribly, since I went without Evelyng and the boys, but I returned blessed by the Lord in those 11 days and by seeing His hand at work in decisions and encouragement among the brothers there in our neighboring country.

This trip was a great enrichment to my life and to the youth who attended, both I and the other teacher that week saw the interest and companionship

of the young people there, as well as sharing in their burdens and struggles.

About us: as I shared with you before, Nathan is growing and starting to eat, which just shows you how quickly time passes! That's something that I keep thinking about as I see David and Nathan growing. David did very well in his exams in



school, and it fills us with joy to see him learn and grow in knowledge. We continue to pray for our goals and the challenges God has given us as a family, that God would show us His ways and guide us in these challenges,

which certainly involve all four of us. We ask that you continue to pray for that, since our own humanity stirs up certain fears in us, but we trust in God for the future, as long as we are faithful today in all that we do.

Thank you again for praying for us and for your offerings which hold us up, we continue praying and thanking God for your lives and for making us part of your families. We love you very much.
