Youth Ministry: We just had our first joint meeting for the year where the theme was "Unity in the Church." The three different age groups (adolescents, college, and young adults) all participated, along with the youth's parents. The purpose of

including the parents is to share with them, not just the gospel but also our goal as to why we have regular youth meetings and the importance of us working together in order to form in their children the next generation of leaders for the

Lord's work. We had an encouraging time together in God's Word as we witnessed the participation of the youth serving both before and at the end of the meeting. We thank the Lord for this meeting and believe that the objectives were completed through it.



Cell Group: We continue meeting with families every Friday for a time of communion in the houses of our brothers in Christ. This time has been quite enriching, as the families that attend show great interest and ask questions concerning how to raise their children and how to improve their home life. Honestly, this group is a blessing to us as we are learning along with them and growing in



prayer and service. Something worthy of highlighting is that these families have become quite involved in the church and in service to our God. We thank God for this great step.

Evangelism: We continue going out each Wednesday with young adults, along with three adolescents who have now joined the group, to share Christ in two different places. We hope that there will be another place in order to have a larger area to evangelize.

Teaching: It is a privilege to teach each Sunday evening in the church and often in the mornings as well, along with teaching in the cell group and youth group, but at the same time it is also a great responsibility as it requires transmitting God's truth to others. Brothers, please pray for me that I would continue to be faithful in the grace of God, along with my wife as she disciples others, but above all that we would begin by being good teachers in our home with our children. We believe that this will give us strength in the transmission of God's word.

Our Family: We thank God for his provision during this time, with David's schooling, with his good health, as well as Nathan's. But I will share with you in regard to my health, asking you to please pray. On Friday, May 18th I will have surgery on my right leg. It won't be super extreme, but a vein will be extracted. This will be the first operation that I have ever had and after that I will have approximately a month of recovery time. Brothers, every time that something similar has happened to me, God has allowed me to



experiment times of stillness in order to hear his voice. The truth is that I am a little uncertain, which causes me to further trust in God.

Also, brothers, this is the first time that I have shared with you this request, for which I asked permission to do so. We have seen the necessity for a car for our family, now that it includes four people. Coming and going to minister and out and about with the family has become at times quite complicated as we have to go by bus. We are praying and I share this prayer request with you that God would provide a vehicle for our family.

I thank you brothers for the part you play in our lives. We feel even more committed to serve our Lord and it is our prayer to God that you would be blessed and enriched in the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ.
