Dear Family and Friends,

Thank you so much for your prayers for my teaching trips to Peru in Nov. and to India in Dec.! God blessed my teaching in wonderful ways and it was a privilege to help equip these servants of God to teach the Word of God and the Gospel to many others.

In Sisa, Peru in Nov., I taught New Testament Survey to 25 students and they did a fantastic job. In December, I went to Visakhapatnam, India and taught 25 pastors a course on "How to teach the Bible effectively" using good teaching principles and methods. These pastors are facing severe persecution. In the last 2 years, 4 members of the ministry we are partnering with have been martyred. The government has a goal to destroy 20,000 Christian churches by the end of 2020. Please pray for them!

Also, we have some great news to share with you — our grandson Emmanuel Taylor was born on Dec. 1 to our oldest son Daniel and his wife Alexandra. Emmanuel is a healthy, growing, beautiful baby boy. In Jan., our granddaughter Elsie turned 1, and we are enjoying so much being grandparents!
