## **Dear Brothers**,

Once again, I would like to share with you what God is doing in the different ministries



that he has placed us in. This summer has been very busy; however, it has also been quite a satisfying time here in Peru.

**Summer Camps:** We had three weeks of camp that were tiring but encouraging, seeing the fruit that God is bringing about. We began with a week for kids, followed by adolescents and ending with young adults. We had the help of three young adults who came from Colombia to assist with counseling and teaching, alongside another couple who came from the Dominican Republic.







God brought a good group of campers to these weeks, along with many volunteers who gave of their time to help with different tasks.

**Evangelistic Campaigns**: God blessed us by bringing groups from abroad to do outreach through sports and medical assistance. The purpose was to not only have special activities for the people, but also to share with them what we consider much more important, the Gospel. Along with those who came from the United States, we had many members from our



church here who participated. What a joy to see members from different generations helping out with these evangelistic outreaches. We had help from older members, couples, youth and even children! We thank God for his great favor in

allowing us to share his Word with others.

**Youth:** We have begun our regular meetings for this year with the three youth groups in our church: the adolescents (ages 13-17),



youth/college (age 18-24), and young adults (25 and up). As is our custom, we have started our regular meetings after all the special summer activities. The youth, without a doubt, are feeling motivated after the camps and





outreaches. By doing this we complete one of our main purposes, which is to train the next generation. In the last couple years, we have seen this become more of a reality in our church in a very tangible way. We ask that you would pray for us that we would walk in the fear of the Lord, in order to carry out this task with humility and consistency, that we might be examples for the youth to follow as we challenge them to serve God by our lifestyle. For we are sure that out of this group, God will raise

up future leaders, pastors, and missionaries from our church.

**Us:** As I mentioned our summer was quite tiring, but these last couple weeks we had some time to rest and be encouraged as we continue to serve the Lord.
