To that end, we have developed a clinic restoration and upgrade project. We have determined a budget and hope to engage the services of a Nairobi based contractor just as soon as funds are raised. The single biggest upgrade requirement is that we must put in a suspended ceiling in the entire building to keep birds from entering the clinic rooms.
