About Us



Alisson

Alisson was born in Tegucigalpa. She received Christ as her Savior when she was a little girl. She studied Dentistry at the National University of Honduras and graduated in 2009. She has had different ministry opportunities inside and outside her local church. She has been involved in short-term brigades to serve through her profession in remote communities where there is no access to any dental health services. She has also served in music ministry with her gift of playing the flute. Alisson has a lot of experience working in ministry with children and adolescents. She currently serves God with her ministry in the community dental clinic, where she serves more than 90 children in a church daycare facility. In addition to this, through her mobile dental clinic (our car with dental things inside) she serves the children in rural schools around our community.

Abner

Abner was born in Santa Rosa de Copan. He studied at the Central American Theological Seminary of Guatemala where he graduated in 2008 with a Bachelor of Bible and Theology. He met Christ as his Savior when he was a little boy during a holiday Bible school. He has served as Associate Pastor, Capellan, Director of organizations dedicated to working with children and youth. He currently serves as Professor of the Mobile Biblical Institutes, the exposition of the Word of God in churches nationwide, camps and retreats. Every week he travels twice to give pastoral support to a small church in the mountains of the department of Intibuca.



Ian Andres

Ian Andres blessed our family on September 17, 2013. He is a very intelligent child. He is currently studying First Degree at the Christian Academy La Providencia. Ian Andres travels with his parents to different places to serve in churches and brigades where he is always willing to serve others because he loves being with people.

Our Ministry

Mobile Biblical Institutes

The teaching of the Word of God is a very important part of Abner's heart. He travels to two communities in southern and eastern Honduras to serve a group of around 20. They are leaders and pastors who do not have the possibility to travel to study. Abner is convinced that his ministry of the Mobile Biblical Institutes is worth investing in the formation of these men of God.



Ministry of Preaching through Conferences

Abner has the privilege of being invited to teach and preach in many churches nationwide. He regularly attends camps, retreats, church anniversary ceremonies and other special activities.

Evangelism

Abner serves as the head of a national evangelism movement. This movement urges local churches to resume their passion for Gospel preaching. The national evangelism movement also trains pastors and leaders on the issue of evangelism and counseling for new believers.



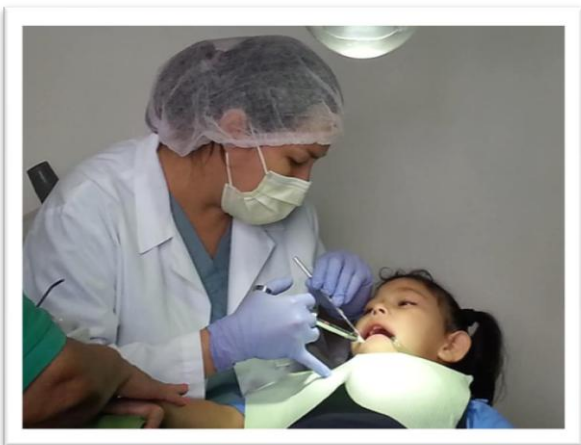
Pastoral Support

Since January 2019, God has given Abner and Alisson the privilege of traveling to a small rural church in the mountains of Intibuca. On Wednesdays and Sundays of each week, they are with this church, to preach, teach, evangelize and provide dental services.

Bible study

Every Saturday at 6:30 am, Abner attends a grocery store where he studies the Word of God with more than 20 employees and the owner of this business. They are currently studying the book of Romans.

Dental Clinic



Alisson is very involved with her ministry in the dental clinic. She serves 90 children from the daycare at our local church. These children are children of single mothers, who generally do laundry and ironing for others. These children have been blessed with free dental treatments. In addition to this, Alisson has adopted the Los Alpes School and the surrounding community that visits Alisson every week. The children of this school are benefiting from the ministry of the mobile clinic. and motivate the church to fulfill God's mission.

Mobile Library

Abner and Alisson are presenting the Gospel in public schools using the strategy of a mobile library. The strategy is to provide a box of books for the teachers to stimulate a love of reading in children. There are prizes for children who read more books. A small "graduation" is done when they finish reading a



box of books and the Gospel is preached to them.

Our needs

3. Provision of equipment and materials for the dental clinic
4. Provision of books for the mobile library.
