Dear Friends,

A couple of years ago, Lolly encouraged me to do a "free" hearing test. After an hour and half and spending \$2k, I realized what I had been missing. Have you experienced this? I guess we all do when we get older. What about spiritually, have you gotten hard of hearing? Hebrews 5:11 says the readers were hard of hearing. When you study the seven churches mentioned in Revelation 2 and 3 you will find they had the same problem. It took a wake-up call from the Lord Jesus to show them their real condition. It is amazing how deaf we can be to our situation. Churches get in a rut of tradition and habit, and they slowly lose the ability to hear the voice of the Holy Spirit.

In fact, many churches and students that I work with ignore the presence or need for the Holy Spirit. They are afraid of being labeled extreme. When you talk about the Christian life, they focus on obedience but not our Helper. My passion is to help churches return to their first love and learn to discern God's plans for His church. Busyness does not equate with effectiveness, nor fruitful disciple making. Events do not produce disciples, and these lessons must be learned.

Recently, I had the joy of assisting a church in Bogota with discovering their next steps toward becoming healthier. We began with looking at the seven churches, noting the descriptions of Christ, the circumstances, the call to action, the consequences of disobedience, and the promises to the over-comers. They heard from the Lord, and we worked together to discover practical next steps in the process of revitalization.

Not everyone present from the church was excited. Some of the old guard pushed back when I introduced the barriers to change. I don't think they saw themselves as barriers but as protectors of the status quo. I pray the elders and leaders will not bow to a few that want to challenge the process. We made great progress, but they have work to accomplish before I return for a follow up assessment. Please pray they read the materials and have the necessary meetings.

The political situation Colombia is somewhat tenuous with the current situation in Venezuela. There are many Colombian guerrillas and paramilitary members in Venezuela. No one knows what the future holds. But I know churches in Venezuela will need help recovering from the mass exodus.
