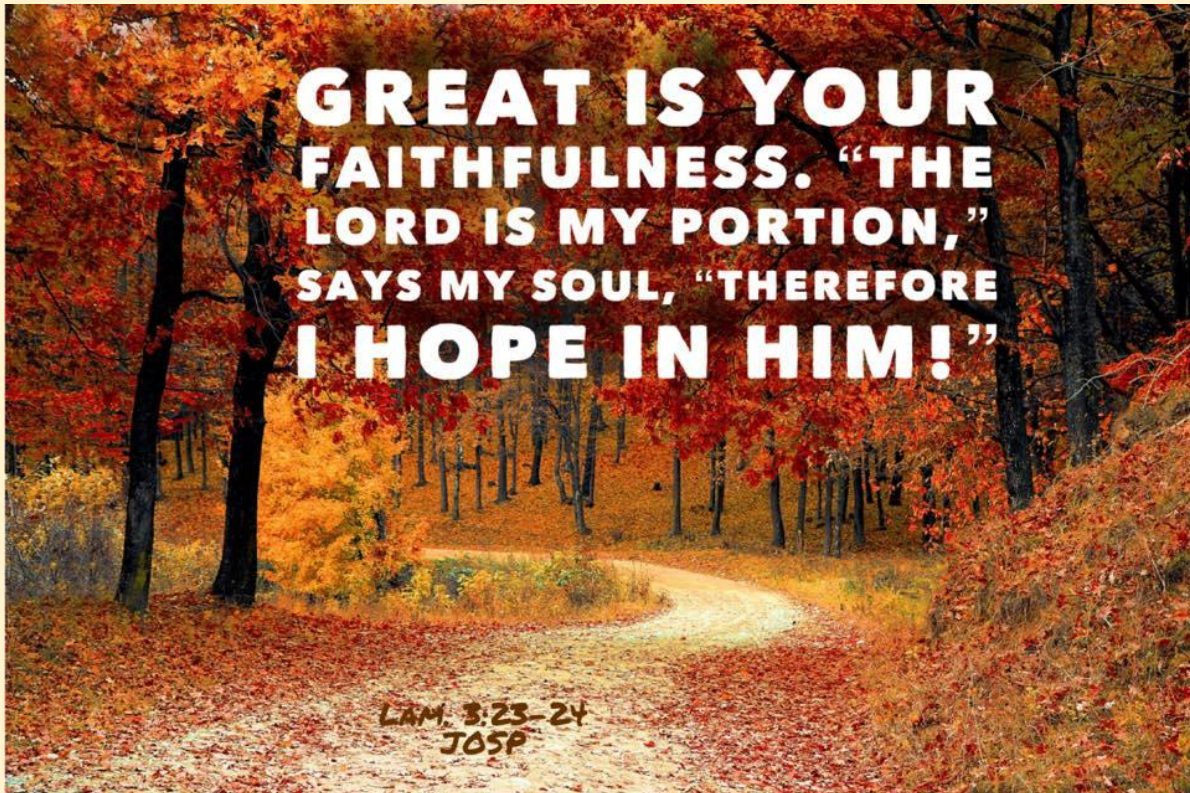

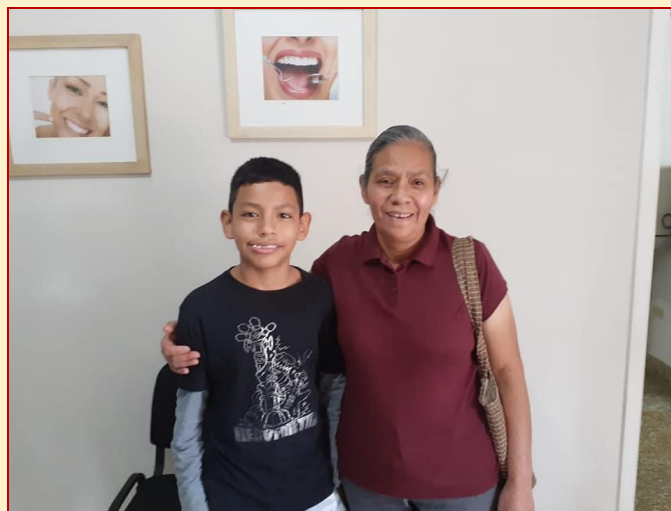
## Ministry with Children

In December we received a visit from our friends Jamey and Des Ramsey. Their hearts are in and for Honduras. They visit us every year to celebrate Thanksgiving with us. On this occasion we developed a Vacation Bible School with the children of the Alps. Jamey was in charge of music and Des helped us with some Bible lessons.



## The Ministry of Community Dental Clinic

Alisson continues to serve through the Dental Clinic. There are many people who come in search of a solution for dental health. Some people cannot pay for their treatments, but this does not prevent them from receiving friendly treatment and a timely response to relieve their pain. The young man in the picture arrived in the company of his grandmother because his mother works all day and could not accompany him. He was very afraid when visiting other dentists. He literally would run out of the clinics. Thank God during his experience at the Clinic he showed a very good attitude. He had been feeling badly due to the pain caused by severe tooth decay in many of his teeth. Alisson was able to start the treatment and is committed with God's help to restore optimal function of his teeth. Alisson's permanent prayer is that God can use her hands and her profession to serve those who need it most.



## Ministry of Preaching

Thank God, Abner continues to receive invitations to preach in and out of the city. Abner has set out to faithfully preach the Word of God and trust in what God can do through it. Abner preaches to youth groups and churches. It is a privilege to expose the truth of God which can transform lives.



## Ministry with Adolescents

Halfway through last year, the leaders of the Church of the Alps asked us to start a weekly meeting with teenagers. It is a small group, normally we have between 8 and 10 young people. We are very encouraged to continue investing our time in the spiritual formation of these teenagers who are surrounded by an environment of vices, sexual promiscuity, violence, and other problems. During these months we taught about loving oneself as God loves you, choosing your friends well, using technology for the Glory of God, caring for the body as a temple for God, and other various topics. Our prayer is for God to raise a generation that loves and serves Him in this community.



## Ministry of Leadership Formation

During these months we have conducted two trainings for Sunday school teachers. We have used the theme of the book "Teaching to Change Lives." Our purpose was to inspire teachers in their teaching ministry, to show them the great privilege as well as the great responsibility of teaching the Word of God. We tried to leave this thought in the minds and hearts of the teachers: "The Word of God was not given for our information only, but for our transformation."
