Working for God in Honduras

Beloved brothers, sisters and friends in Christ,

It is an honor to write you so that you will know that the Lord's work is continuing forward. We thank God for your prayers and offerings. We hope that you are well and living under God's protection.

We send a special greeting to the families that have lost loved ones. We have been praying for you all as well as for those who have been going through difficult problems. God is good and has promised to be with us every day until the end of the world.

There is much to tell you about the work of the Lord here in Honduras, but we want to start by asking for your prayers for the political situation in Honduras given that the country is passing through one of the most difficult times in its history. The poor are getting poorer. There is much drug trafficking, human trafficking and disappearances of boys and girls. There is high unemployment, murders, and more petty and organized crime. I tell you all this because it is having a tremendous effect on the normal development of churches. This is leading us missionaries to create new strategies to take the gospel to the people. This creates new challenges for life and ministry.

Currently, as missionaries we have dedicated ourselves to the training of young people and adults so that they may work as local missionaries. Please pray at this time for three young people that are being trained in this missionary work. They are Yovanny Vasquez, Lesly Flores and Susairy Castro. Additionally, we are continuing to train leaders in Balibrea to equip them for the purpose of taking the gospel to other places in Honduras.

We have begun a group with men of different ages for the purpose of study and friendship. We are meeting each Wednesday in different places in the city. I ask for your prayers for this new stage in ministry. God is good and he is working in the lives of the men who attend these meetings.

The children's feeding program still continues thanks to your offerings. We encourage you to continue praying and collaborating with this wonderful ministry that has resulted in many people coming to Christ.

In regards to the scholarship ministry, we are praying that when December comes we will have the money necessary to continue helping these young people and children to keep on studying.

The Sunday school and prayer meetings in Balibrea have been good. But in the past months attendance has dropped due to the fears people have as well as the distances that people have to travel to get to the place where we meet.

Due to a lack of transportation and other economic resources we have not been going frequently to the Agua Salada community. But our brother Santana and his family have continued working hard in the work of the Lord. God has provided a property and now we are praying that God will provide the economic resources to build a church and Sunday School classrooms.

A personal prayer request: Please pray for our own safety and the safety of our children. Also please pray that God will provide the finances to meet our needs.
