We are pleased to announce that our medical clinic in the little village of Muthetheni, Kenya will be reopening around the end of March. About three years ago we had to suspend clinic services after a change in government mandated requirements for clinics. During my trip there in January, we got things started and thanks to the help of many, our restoration project is nearing completion. We will soon, once again, be able to help meet the medical needs of those living in and around the village of Muthetheni.



But more than just providing “band aids” and medicine for the body, the clinic will also be a dispenser of help for the soul. Patients will soon find available everything from a simple Gospel message, to Bible study correspondence courses, a library of Christian resources, and interaction with a pastor. The goal is that those coming to the clinic for physical help will also encounter the aroma of Christ and come to know Him or be encouraged in their walk with Him. To that end, if you
