Greetings and thank for your love and support. We pray daily for you and ask our Father for His best for your lives.


In Argentina, we are living in one of the worst times. This pandemic has hit us hard and the number of people infected continues to grow. Many families are living through difficulties with illness and death. And we add to those here, our beloved friends and co-

workers in the jungles of Venezuela and Colombia. Covid-19 has hit them hard. As our spiritual children and former students we have kept in close contact, and they have shared with me what their lives have been like these past few months. One of the experiences



that has had the greatest impact on my heart was this, "Teacher, please come and help us!" We are so far away and it is impossible to go, now more than ever. We have fallen on our knees and joined them in prayer, with great pain in our hearts.

Our family, praise God is good. We have had a few health issues, but nothing as complicated as Covid-19. This time for Monica and me has turned into something very special. We have dedicated ourselves to prayer, sharing daily what God has taught us, discipling, counseling, preaching; all this on the internet. Quarantine is very strict here and enforced, and we have been living this way for 6 months. But

God in His grace has allowed us to participate in His work. Monica has been teaching pastors wives in Buenos Aires, discipling and counseling women here in Cordoba, and in many other cuntries. Costa Rica, disciplining men, training, daily devotions and even planting new churches in northern Cordoba. Through counseling I have had the opportunity to guide people to surrender their lives to Jesus, and I then connect them with local pastors for further discipleship or if that is not available, I disciple them online. We are making various teaching

videos and sending them to churches in the jun-

gles of Venezuela and Colombia.

- I have two up-coming conferences to teach.
