World Reach has stepped up to leverage technology to reach many pastors, leaders, and churches. We have continued to have our Bogota Bible Institute class through Zoom and YouTube. This allowed us to invite many other pastors and leaders. After a while, we had people from other cities asking us to expand our Bible Institute to their cities. Please pray for wisdom as we strengthen our contacts and expand our influence in Colombia.

Since churches and businesses have been closed, the Latin American World Reach team created an SD card project. Our goal is to reach pastors and leaders in rural areas in Central and South America who do not have internet access but do have a cellphone. They will get a curriculum of six classes and homework in a 32GB SD card, that will help equip them to equip others during difficult times. The Colombian team was assigned with the Fear vs Faith class.

What an interesting topic to teach in times where faith helps us overcome fear.

Finally, I feel honored to help Colombian pastors connect with World Reach missionary Bobby Wilson through Zoom. He is coaching them on different topics like how to be a church during a pandemic, stay closed, or reopen your church, and marks of spiritual maturity. I think this has been a spiritual refreshment for pastors and for me.
