
News from the Huyhua family in Lima Peru. 2021

Dear brothers, we begin a new year in the will of Our Good God and as is our custom, sharing the manifestation of his work is always a privilege and a blessing.

We all know how difficult 2020 was and what 2021 continues to be; however, we trust that God is God and never makes mistakes, and we pray and hope that each of us will respond with even greater fidelity this year, assuming the challenges, knowing our God is sovereign and reigning, even in times like these.

Every Friday we continue with the cells, already four meetings, and we are having a little more in attendance, around 33 to 34 families. We meet with them from 7 at night and we share times of prayer, words of encouragement, dynamics and the inevitable study



of the Word of God. The topic that we have started with them is: "And God Directed Him to Good" (the life of Joseph). We are seeing good interest and at the same time building



time in the words of the holy book, the Bible. We conduct each study through Zoom, since as you may know, the pandemic prevents us from meeting in person for now.

Tuesdays: I am having the opportunity to teach from the Word of God by way of studies on the book of Joshua, going sequentially through each chapter. And we have seen growing not only the attendance but also the interest of the Church. Without a doubt it is the hand

of our good God, for He is the one who gives the growth (1 Corinthians 3: 6-7).

Pray that God will continue to use us and give his wisdom and guard our hearts and testimonies; since, along with the family unit, this study is also with families, leaders and



new assistants from the entire Church, in total about 70 families.

Thursdays: We teach the word of God at this time by way of preaching, also virtually. The theme that we carry is "The Book of Nehemiah", almost finishing it. With certainty it has been challenging to our church, and in the same way, we see involved at this time about 77 brothers and families. It is a joy to see them studying and being attentive in the Bible study.

Young people: Thank God that with the work group and coordinators we are having a different summer. Despite being virtual meetings, they are filled with dynamism and are



propagating through the challenges and competencies needed to instill God's Word.

The number of teenagers with whom we meet on Saturdays at 4:30pm is averaging around 30 to 31 boys. At 7:00pm we have about 25 young people who meet and another group of about 30 to 33

at this time. We definitely give God the praise for them and their constancy in attendance every Saturday, despite knowing that this year we have not had a camp for children or for

young people. We regret this since it was the opportunity to involve them to serve God. All of this is due to the Covid; but we do not stop doing what God has called us to do, impart his biblical teaching, and there we rest.

As a family we remain grateful to God for his goodness and care, seeing so many deaths among brothers today. We see that life is definitely a gift that God grants us to serve him and to share the glorious gospel that gives eternal hope; and it is our focus not to lose sight of this priority and calling.

We also give thanks to God for each one of you, for your prayers and the tremendous blessing that they are for us. They encourage



us to continue faithfully serving our God and savior.

We share that God has also been providing for us to buy a family vehicle. and we already have a little more of that provision as we continue to pray that God himself completes what is lacking. So far we already have almost 10,000 dollars saved for this, and many of You are part of it! Thank you and again thank you very much for your offerings and generous hearts! Sometimes we talk as a family and we feel unworthy of so much Grace. Help us to pray to complete what would be missing (which will be more or less 4,000 or 5,000 more, since the total price price is around 15,000), and that if it is God's will, that we will soon be able to aquire a vehicle in good condition.

Brothers, we are still indebted to God and to you for everything, we love and sincerely thank you.
