

News from the Huyhua family in Lima Peru.

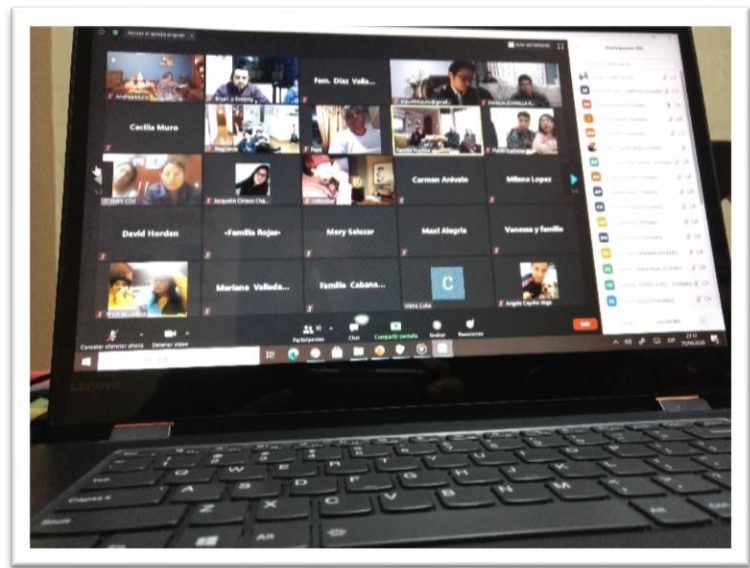

Beloved it is a pleasure to again share with you the grace that our good God allows us to live even in difficult times like these. In this opportunity we will share how we live this moment of our lives in Perú, and how God still allows us to serve Him.

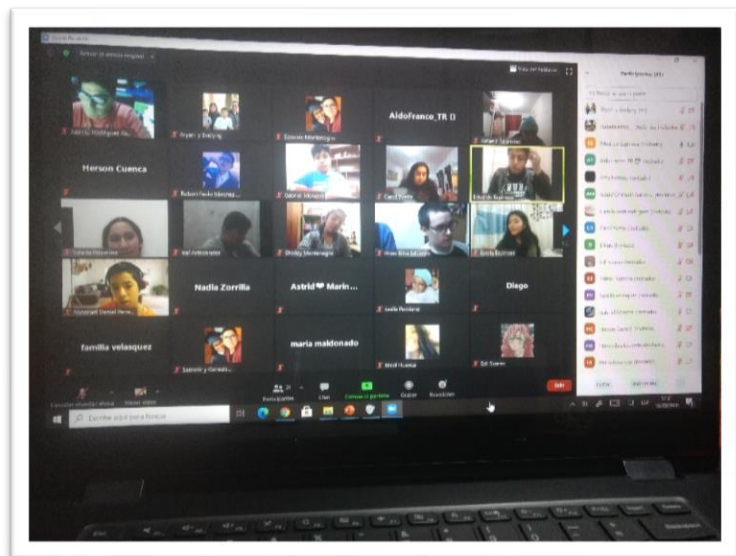
Youth: we continue ministering to the 3 meetings of the youth of our church, with the purpose of forming leaders for the ministries that God in His grace allowed the church to start years ago.

In each meeting we have at least 25 to 35 young people, for example:



Adolescents: every Saturday we have a group of about 35 with which we connect thru Zoom and the group has been quite faithful participating and constant in their assistance. The teaching has been challenging.

Teens: they are also a group of more or less 25 teens that regularly



participate with interest in the meetings. We thank God that we already see their interest in learning the Word of God and their desire to grow. We also see that in spite of this pandemic and the crisis in our country and in the world, these teens have not stopped sharing their faith with friends and families.



Young adults: every Saturday we have 32 to 37 young adults who participate also in times of studying and communion in Christ, in His truth.

Beloved, we thank God that each of above mentioned meetings now can rely on families, which we had proposed to help us out, and we see these families are committed to God and us and are serving selflessly. The meetings are now very seriously formalized.

This without doubt is a reason for joy and happiness to keep on serving our Lord with more enthusiasm. With this group we meet every two weeks on Wednesday, to coordinate, evaluate and pray for each meeting, be it for the new young people or for problems and definitely to thank God for His goodness with this ministry.

As you can observe, Beloved, every Saturday we meet with nearly 100 young people, that God in His goodness and favor undeservedly allows us to advise.

Please pray for the fidelity of the brothers, sisters and families that are helping us, that we will be faithful and simple of heart, but also that we will rightly teach the truth of God to our next generation.

Evelyn and I frequently meet with several of them during the week and on Saturday morning for discipling lessons. We do this thru Zoom as in our country we are not allowed to minister personally yet.

Cell group: Every Friday we see the interest of families to meet up with us virtually. We have 27-30 connections, but each connection is a family and together we have a time of prayer, sharing and elaborating themes of the Word of God. They, like our youth, have shown fidelity and assist in these sessions

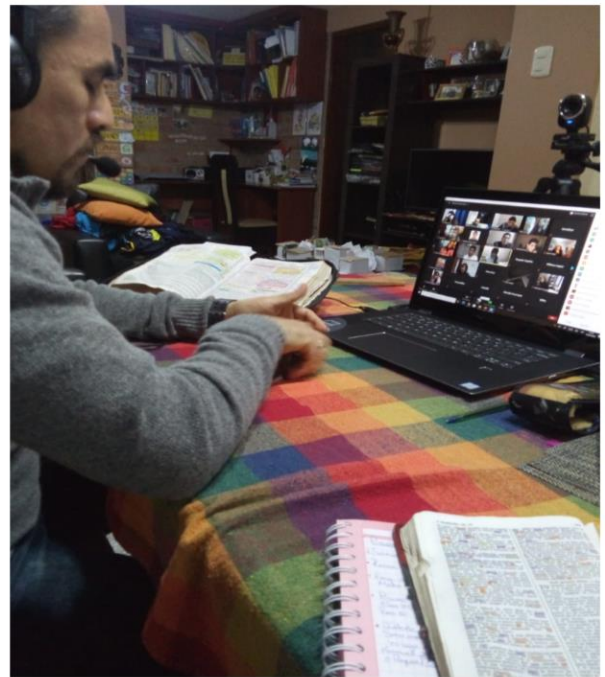
constantly. We see the love and affection towards family, as they share their burdens and struggles with the group, and so encourage each other to stay in the Christian race.

Biblical Teaching: Every Thursday evening I have the opportunity to teach the whole congregation thru Facebook. We just finished the theme of Heaven, and are now going to develop the theme of the purposes of God. Please pray that I can teach each Thursday with the fear of God; as you know, this is a huge responsibility.

OTHER: We received an invitation from Santiago, Chile, to teach the Word of God to the church in San Bernardo. It was a time of much edification and encouragement.

We were also invited to share a devotional with a church in Salamanca, Lima, so we could minister to the brothers and sisters with biblical teaching.

Furthermore we will have the opportunity, during the second week of October, to minister to a church in Bello, Medellin, Colombia, who



invited us and trusted us with the privilege of preaching the Word of God.

So Beloved, we have had good opportunities of serving God during this period of time and that is only due to the grace our good God gives us.

Family: Brothers and Sisters we request your faithful prayers for my father. He had a PSA test done and his level has not diminished so the doctor now wants to do a biopsy of his prostate. At first my mother was hurt and worried, because she feared it was



something serious; but she is now trusting. My brothers and I are trusting in the purposes and will of our God, because we know He will not allow anything that is not for our good (Rom. 8:28). This Saturday they will do the biopsy and we will receive the result in a week. Please help us pray for this situation. My father is a God fearing man and my mother a godly woman; but the truth is we need you to help us pray for this, as you know we are weak men in our humanity.

We do not want to speed up any results, but are waiting on God for the well-being of my father. Their names are **Víctor and María Luisa Huyhua**.

David and Nathan are ok, thanks to our good God, busy with their schoolwork; but we as a couple and as parents need your prayers to guide them in the ways of the Lord with our example too.

We desire that they will grow up in the ways of the Lord and serve Him. As parents, that is our fervent yearning and prayer.

Beloved I share with you another petition of prayer: for the last 2 years we have been praying for a car for our family as we saw that this was necessary. During this pandemic it has become more difficult to travel by bus, but God has been providing a small amount which some of you have donated, and we hope that God will keep it growing until we reach the goal to buy a car, obviously God willing.

Furthermore, if my father needs any treatment, it would be a good to have a vehicle to transport him to his future appointments, if necessary.

The peruvian government has not lifted the quarantine; that they will do, God willing, next year in January. We are only allowed to mobilize during specific hours. As a precaution our sons have not left the house since March, because that would mean getting on a bus, putting them at risk for a future infection of Covid 19. That's why we share this necessity with you, so you can keep this in your prayers; that if it is the will of God to provide what is missing, we can have our own car.
