Actual situation in Peru

With regards to the situation in Peru, epidemiologists declared that pandemic fatigue^a is one of the causes of the new breed for the Covid -19. After such a long time of restrictions, the people are tired. The new breeds of Covid-19 were not adequately dealt with, because of the lack of sufficient community effort. Besides, the restart of economic activities accelerated trafficking and interaction of people.

An important group that was mostly affected mentally, psychologically and emotionally- (anxiety, depression, burnout, insomnia, impotency, desperation, death etc.)- is the personnel of health :(. They are working on the Covid -19 cases in a difficult situation with few resources. They see patients dying daily without being able to help them or to let them say goodbye to their families. A study shows that 30% of the people have been infected with the virus Covid-19. Thanks to God Peru now has vaccines and started vaccinating people in health, uniformed groups and after that the most vulnerable. This vaccination campaign is voluntary and the intention is to vaccinate 24.5 million persons of 18 years and up.

School holidays and activities of the church

During the months January and February 2021, the school was on holidays. Due to the pandemic we didn't have camps for the children, adolescents and young adults this year. The church services and bible studies continued virtually. It has been a year since we've had church services and classes at La Roca Christian School.

The Twin Missions International team visits Peru annually to have a medical campaign in the neighborhoods of Lima. This year however, they decided to have a virtual medical campaign. This took place from the 6th to the 10th of February 2021.
