

"News from the Huyhua family"




Dear brothers and sisters, we greet you once again in the Grace of our good God and Savior.

We agree that this time is still difficult for each of you and us, and above all we wanted to share with you that we are praying for the United States since we know that they are going

through times of natural disasters, and it is our wish that the Almighty continue to guard and protect these difficult moments, and that also as a nation many turn to the Lord of heaven.

Now we here in Peru are also at a time where health is still at risk and the death rate, although it has reduced, is still critical. Our health system in hospitals collapsed and with a significant shortage of oxygen; however, the Good Shepherd, The Rock of Israel (Genesis 49:24), continues to keep us alive. And we understand that this continues to motivate us to look forward to his coming and to even virtually share the glorious Gospel of the Hope of eternal life.

1. We continue to meet virtually every Friday with families, and what we recognize is that they continue to remain faithful in their virtual attendance, with 30 to 33 links,





considering that each link involves families. With whom we have just carried out the study of: "AND GOD DIRECTED IT TO GOOD", based on the life of Joseph in the book of Genesis. It was a blessing to be able to teach this topic, and a challenge to continue to trust in the sovereignty of God.

Now we have started the series: "THE FRUIT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT", and it is our prayer to our God that it also be one of edification, exhortation and comfort. (1 Corinthians 14: 3) The idea and objective is to consolidate and strengthen both old and new families in the faith.

2. As for the Youth:

- Adolescents: Every Saturday is an opportunity to sow the Word of

God in them and especially the conviction that they can find the Bible as their main tool to sustain themselves in difficult and dangerous times where the identity of

- -Young People: Young people also continue to attend virtually, and our main objective is to help them to be young people with courage to show their faith in the environment where they develop. Since most of this age are in university, their attendance is approximately 25 guys every Saturday.
- **Older Youth**: This group is today a reality, the result of God's work and work in them for more than 10 years. They are people, most of whom are already involved in the work of the Lord. They work and minister in addition to being faithful with their attendance of approximately 33 boys. With them we carry out studies where they can be encouraged to continue and remain faithful in their commitment to God and his Truth.

3. Biblical Studies:

On Tuesdays we develope studies with the Church in general where we have already finished the book of Joshua. It was a challenge and an opportunity to prepare me to learn to



teach and minister with the Word of God, And what was remarkable was the assistance we had and the constancy of the brothers, where every Tuesday we had from 76 to 80 of them joining online. We give glory to God for it. Next Tuesday we will be taking the study in the book of Ecclesiastes.

4. Thursday of Preaching:

We have also been carrying out with our Church in general the study of the book of Nehemiah and now we are continuing with the attributes of God. These studies I share with one of the leaders of our Church, that is to say one Thursday and




the next myself, with the regular attendance of approximately 76 links every Thursday.
