FAMILY NEW

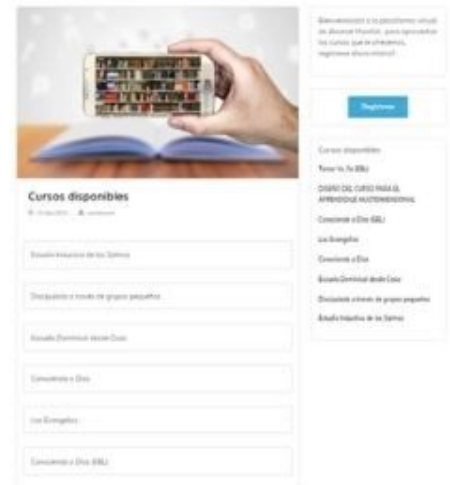
After experiencing covid-19 infection, we now praise God as a family because we are better and little by little we are returning to our daily routine with home, work and classes. Hector was undergoing treatment and visiting the doctor for low blood pressure problems, but with the proper treatment he is back to normal. The girls apparently were not infected, nor was Angelina, however, they were affected a little emotionally.

Although this time was difficult, there was also a lot of learning and reflection: We learned to value family more, the time we shared together, experiencing God's hand in our lives and His care with Angelina's parents. We also thanked the Lord because He provided abundantly for the payments of the medical consultations and medicines. Thank you so much for your prayers and support every step of the way.

HONDURAS

The conditions in Honduras are currently a bit difficult politically, we are in a presidential election year and that brings with it many conflicts in the country. In addition, after the hurricane the general economic situation in the country is not the best, most things have increased making the situation much more difficult for most Hondurans.

Regarding the virus, we are still with restricted circulation measures, especially at night and the use of mouth covers is mandatory. The vaccine for the population has not yet arrived, some donations for health personnel have started to arrive, we hope that soon it will be available to the rest of the population. We ask for your prayers for our country so that God may allow the situation to improve and that the Honduran people in total surrender to his feet.



MINISTRY

At the beginning of the year due to the family crisis in the health area, it was difficult to focus on projects to develop this new year. In Angelina's case, she was traveling to San Pedro Sula to support her parents and sister in the quarantine process. Thank God her father is now well recovered and we have been able to resume our ministry.

In February Hector started Bible classes with a group of leaders and pastors from various areas of the country. The brothers are very excited to be trained. Angelina also started in February the discipleship "Among women", which is a group that God is guiding in their physical and spiritual growth. Currently there are 17 women from different countries (Dominican Republic, Canada, Costa Rica and Honduras). We also reactivated the online classes on the World Outreach virtual platform. We are very happy to be part of the training of many leaders and pastors, not only in Honduras, but also in other countries. We currently have 40 active students and 7 classes available in the area of Bible and Christian ministry. We have also opened the door to share classes through a radio program, we will share the link soon!



The SD card project is already a reality and will be delivered in the following months in Honduras, Peru and Colombia. We praise God for this opportunity. In addition, we continue to support the local church through teaching or preaching. Hector is part of an outreach group in charge of creating a new curriculum and reform for the Mobile World Outreach Bible Institute. We have also invested time in creating a class to support outreach members teaching at IBM. The class is a training to create a multidimensional learning classroom.
