Current Conditions in Colombia

As many of you may have seen in the news and social media, there is a lot going on in Colombia right now. During the entire month of April the mayor of Bogota instated a 3-4 rule. This entailed 3 days of quarantine (Friday-Sunday) and 4 work days. She also reduced work hours. In some zones of the city people could only work from 10am to 6pm. This caused an even greater economic crisis and seemed to be the "final straw" for the people here in Colombia.

Last week the nation began protesting and called for a national strike. Since then there have been riots and protests daily. We have stayed home during this time as much as possible, but have had to get out to complete some paperwork for Eliana's Colombian citizenship. Thankfully, the riots tend to occur in the afternoons and evenings which has allowed us to make appointments in the mornings and avoid any danger. We hope to have Eliana's birth certificate and passport in a week or so.

Ministry Update

As you can probably guess, ministry has been a bit more difficult during this month. The ideal time to visit house-to-house (which is our current format for ministry due to government restrictions) is on weekends. However, during the entire month of April we were in quarantine on weekends and unable to leave our home. We have called and texted many of the families, but we cannot wait until restrictions are lifted and we can visit them again.

studies for kids and adults. In April, we also helped to facilitate the latest Bible Institute class. This was the last formal class for this group of students. We look forward to classes with our new students. Their official classes will begin in July.

Many city bus stations have been excessively damaged.
