BIBLE TEACHING:

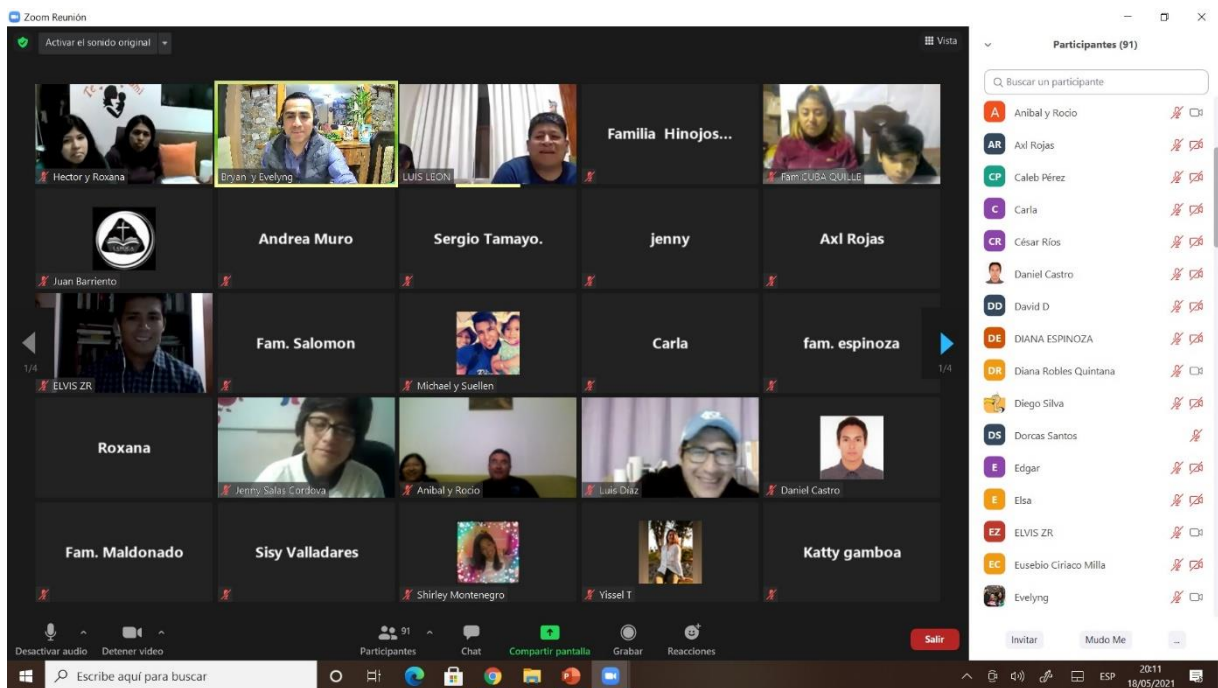

challenging time not only to teach, but also to study and learn from the word of

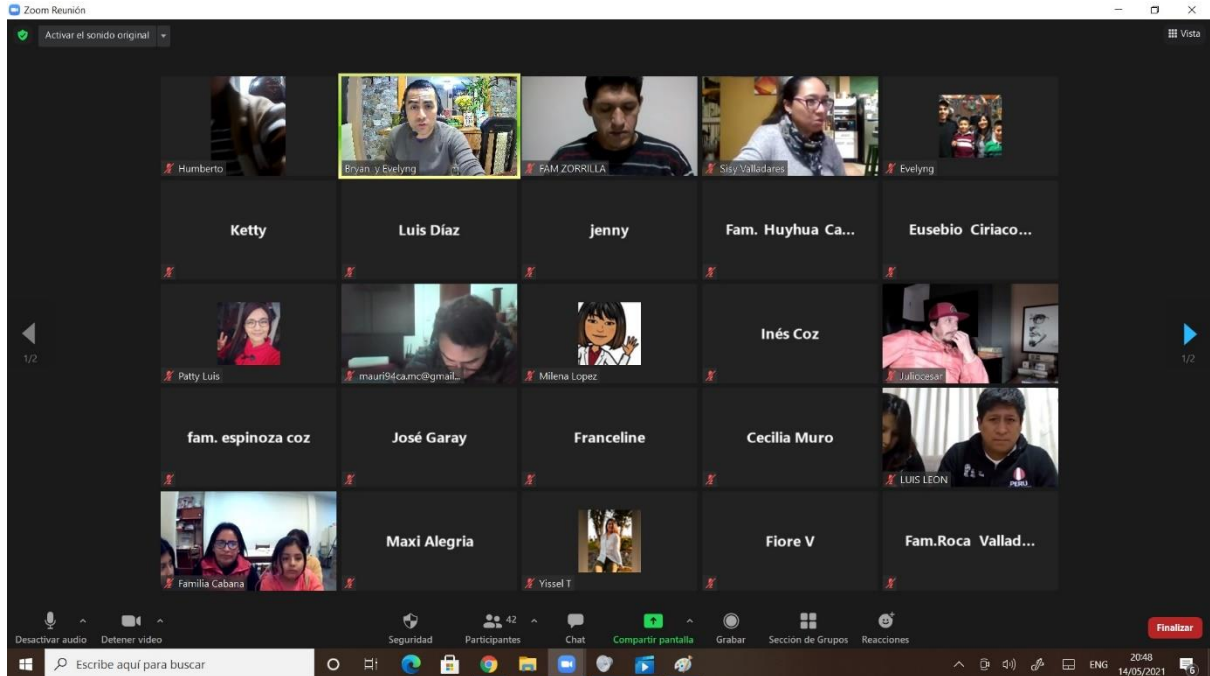

It helps us to grow, studying with greater dedication and a greater heart and commitment to live a life of holiness and fidelity to God. requests, and sing to our God; as well as ask questions and solve them with the Bible, the word of God.

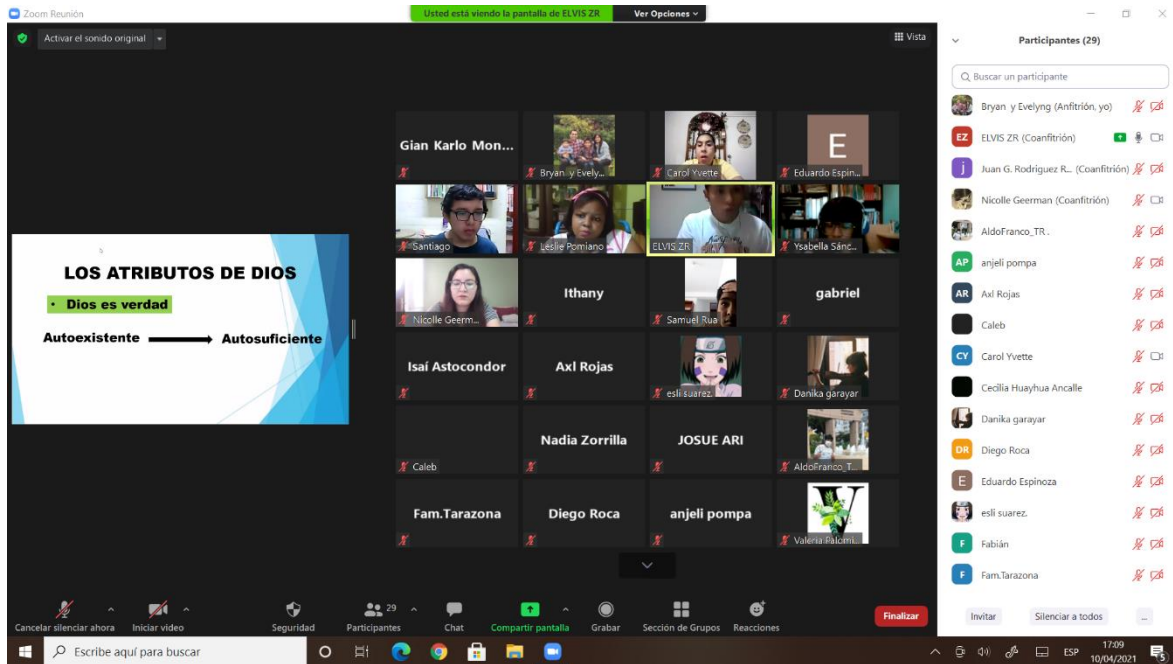

and make choices that will honor His name and be a great witness to a society of young people who live outside the Lord.

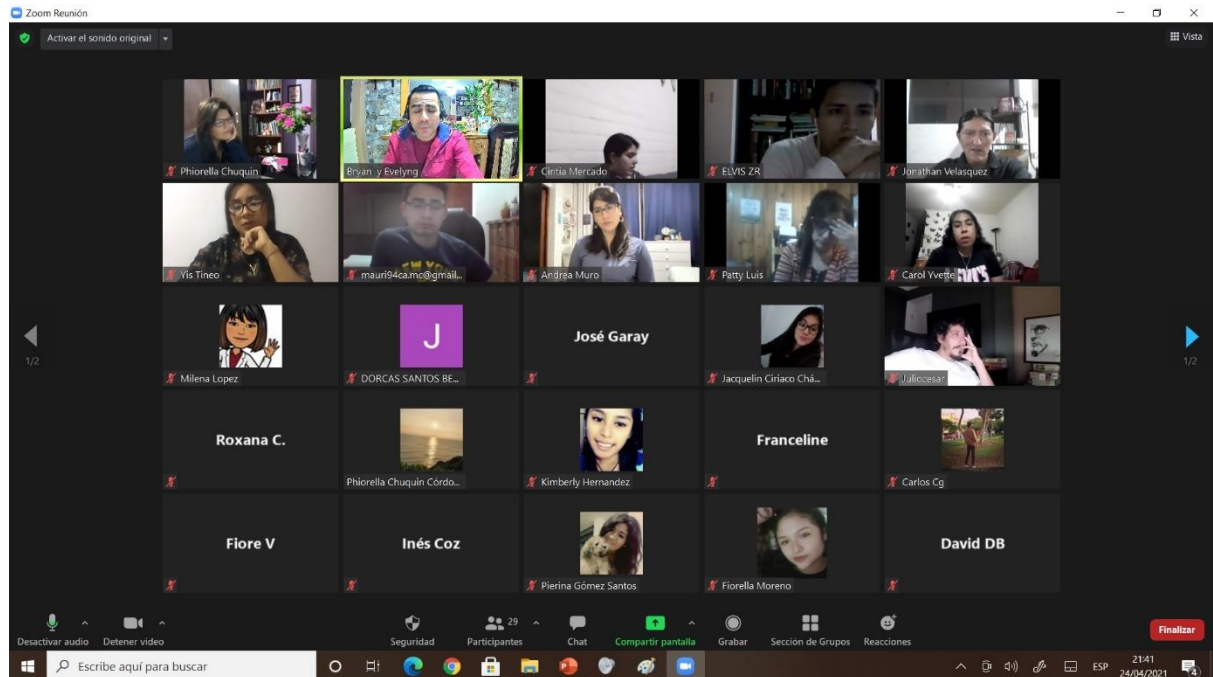
Studies with Young Adolescents: This group is around 30 to 35 boys.



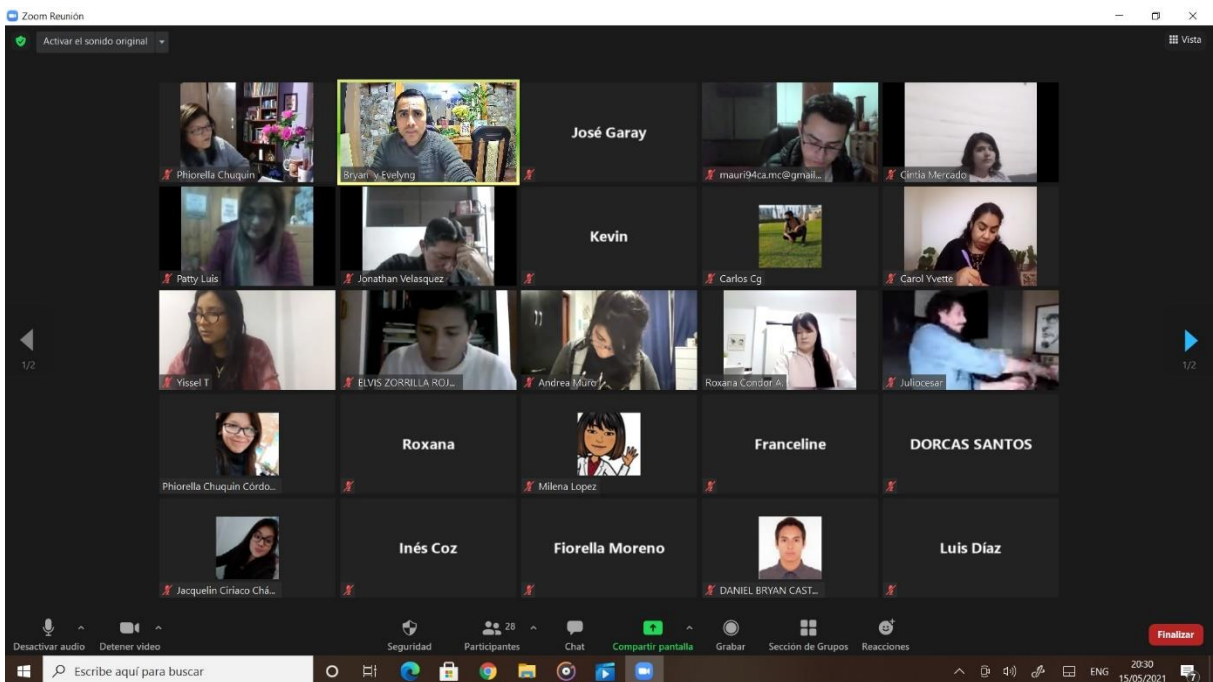

It is for them that we are very intentional in sharing and ministering the word of God.

Studies with Young People: This is a smaller group in number, but more challenging, since most of them are already studying at the university. And as you know, they are challenged and questioned for their faith, both by their friends and by the university professors themselves. It is our Prayer to God that they stand firm in their belief in God, and despite opposition, live godly lives and allow God to use opposition to boldly bear witness to Christ.

Studies with Older Youth: In the case of this group, we meet every Saturday and have not only time to study the word of God, but also pray for the specific



needs of each of them. Most of them are serving God in different areas, be it as a school teacher, or in the ministry of children and adolescents. So we have a



time to thank God for his goodness and remember his favors (**Psalms 103:1-3**).

Pray for them, as we want them to remain steadfast and in God's wisdom for what they do in their service to our God.



Discipleship: With my wife we continue discipling during the week, in the case of Evelyng some girls, and I some boys. The objective is to form Christ in the hearts of several of these girls and boys and to strengthen them in God and his truth.

School: Every Monday and Wednesday I continue teaching the course: **CHRISTIAN FORMATION**,

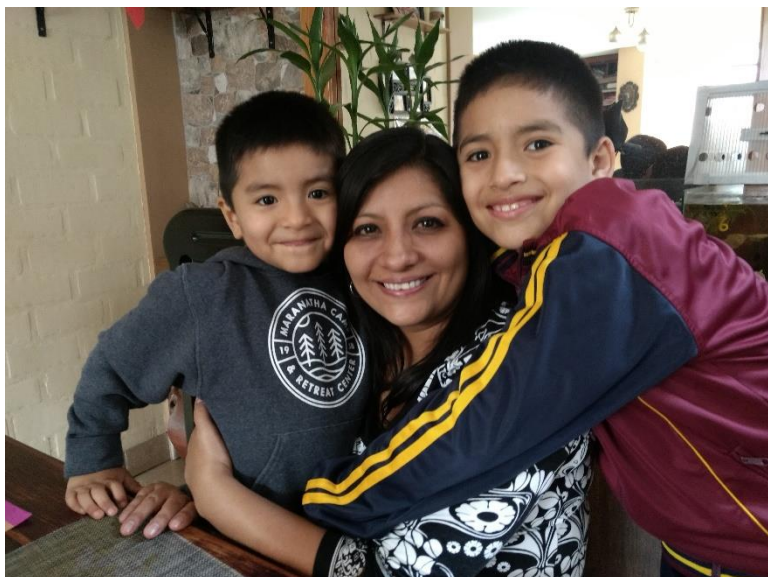
