Dear brother/collaborator.

I greet you cordially from Willemstad, Curacao the country where I was born. I thank God for your support in this difficult time of the pandemic. Be sure that God will reward all who contribute to His work. All those who support His work with prayer, moral or financial support (Galatians 6:8-9) ②! I hope you are trusting and depending on the Lord our God during the second wave of the Covid-19 that is affecting all the countries. Times are getting worse, but Jehovah El Elyon stays in control of everything (Psalm 123: 1-2).

In my last newsletter I mentioned that I was travelling to Curacao in February. Actually, I had to return to Peru before the end of March, but my flight has been cancelled. I don't have a return flight until now. I thank God that I can be in Curacao in this time of crisis due to the second wave of covid-19. Besides the fact that I can support and assist my mother, I can also take care of her. She has more health issues now that she is aging.

Situation of Peru

As I mentioned previously, the second wave of covid-19 has affected Peru



enormously. Peru is in a stage of emergency and is working on a vaccination campaign. Thanks to God, Peru is receiving a greater quantity of Pfizer vaccines. It grew from 50,000 weekly in March to 200,000 weekly in April. The government is negotiating to get the vaccines of Moderna and

Johnson & Johnson. A lot of effort is being made to vaccine as many people as possible. This is the major strategy that Peru is utilizing to counter arrest the contagion of the covid-19.

Unfortunately, they discovered recently, that there have been irregularities with the vaccinations. Politicians, business men and others got vaccinated secretly. Moreover, the vaccine 'Sinopharm' of China has been administrated covertly to certain people, while it was still in the process of clinical testing. Other news states, that a group of elders have received placebos. Due to these irregularities the Peruvian government instituted a platform where the people can make complaints about these issues.

Preparations to start with School

Since the last week of February 'La Roca Christian School' started with the preparations to start the new school year. In Peru the school year runs from March to the end of December. The official opening took place on March 11th and the classes started on March 15th. This school year I got a very interesting task. It entails giving 'tutoria' every two weeks. Some themes that I addressed were the values: respect and responsibility.

- Answers to prayer petitions and fulfilled promises;
- God's protection during the pandemic;
- Stay in Curacao and time with family and brethren of church;
- Commitment of the teachers of La Roca.
- Opportunities for evangelism;
- Grace and favors of God.

- God's mercy for the Peruvian people;
- God's guidance for my school responsibilities and ministries for this year:
- Protection of the missionaries and the ministry of La Roca;
- Wisdom for the management of the school when making decisions;
- Salvation of the members of the new Parliament and the new government;
- Election of a Peruvian president who fears God.
