In the midst of a situation complicated by the Covid-19 pandemic, the Lord allows us to serve Him. We have understood that this situation has forced us to make changes in our lifestyle and ministry, but being paralyzed by it is an option that we have refused to take. We ask that you would not stop praying for us and our ministry here in Honduras.

Dental Clinic

Alisson continues to work in the dental clinic on a limited basis. Only a few patients are treated during the week after filling out a questionnaire about their state of health. Likewise, in the clinic, preventive measures are taken such as taking temperatures, cleaning hands and using footwear, among others. One good news is that due to her high-risk professional practice, Alisson was able to receive the first dose of the Astra Zeneca vaccine. She is still waiting for her second dose.



Prayer Request

That God would continue to protect Alisson in the exercise of her profession and that it would continue to be a means of serving others with first-rate and low-cost dental health treatments.



Ian Andrew's Education

Ian Andres successfully completed second grade. His grades were excellent. It was a challenging year, as he was homeschooled and Alisson was his main teacher during the whole year. We are very grateful to our friend and sister Des Ramsey, who helped us tremendously with English classes.

That God would provide encouragement and strength in this important process of studies. Presently, Abner is taking the Old Testament I course.

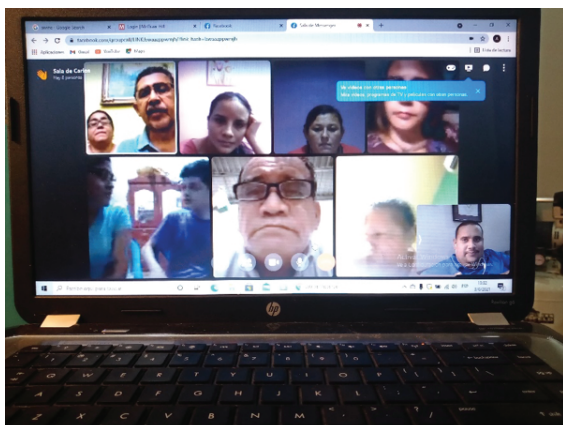
Ministry of Preaching and Pastoral Support

For the last 7 months, we have been supporting a small church in a neighborhood of Siguatepeque. This church has no pastor. Abner has been involved in preaching, and he is responsible for teaching every Sunday morning. Abner also provides pastoral counseling to the leaders of the church. We have also helped some of the believers with packages of food.

Preaching and conferences

Abner continues to serve the national church through preaching and conferences via Zoom. He has preached in churches and youth groups in Siguatepeque, Santa Rosa de Copán, San Pedro Sula, Tegucigalpa and Valle.

Bible School for Leaders

This project is an expansion of the Mobile Bible Institutes, aimed primarily at local church leaders. Abner has traveled to Santa Rosa de Copán and Concepción, Santa Barbara to deliver more than 30 SD cards and USB memory sticks to the same

number of leaders. They will take 4 courses in total and will be finishing the program between November and December of this year.

That the students can learn from each course and that this knowledge will contribute to the process of personal and community transformation.



Classes at the Central American Bible Seminary of Honduras

Abner taught a virtual class on Spanish Grammar Applied to Bible Study. He had 6 students who live in different parts of Honduras and even in the United States.
