




WHAT GOD IS DOING IN THE HUYHUA FAMILY

Beloved Brothers & Sisters,

It is sincerely a blessing to share with you through this letter and also to have communion with you in Christ. These last two months have been somewhat different and also challenging in our family and in ministry. We have continued ministering by the Grace of God through Zoom to different groups.

Family Groups:

We continue our studies and time of sharing every Friday with families from our church. It is a very challenging time where we address questions and share principles of the Word of God.

Some families are new and others are more



mature in faith, but they have a hunger and thirst to learn. This motivates us to be an example and a good witness to them. The goal is to base this time of meeting on the Truth of God. Since most of these families have come to Christ after already establishing a life without God, it is a challenge to have these times with them encouraging change. We use these studies to sow in them the way that God wants them to live now IN CHRIST.

General Groups of Young Adults:

These are groups of different ages, so the schedules and topics of discussion are different for each group.



Teenagers (age 13-17):

We are studying the names and character of God- His attributes and characteristics – with about 33 every Saturday. The teenagers are being faithful in their participation in discussion, but what we want is from them to understand their IDENTITY in Christ and become a generation for God, serving our God. That is why we


are quite dedicated in not only praying for them, but also in having a time where the Word is memorized. These teenagers are challenged to make weekly decisions to cut off what is harmful to their relationship with God so they can follow the Lord in a deliberate and determined way. We take this group of teenagers seriously because very soon most of them will be finishing school and entering a higher level of education where their faith will be challenged.

Young Adults:

Most are university students, and there are about 15 in the bible study group. Their families, mostly Christian, help us with the responsibility of imparting to them the wisdom of God. It is our prayer that they respond with courage and boldness in the place where they attend school and give good testimony of Christ without being ashamed of their faith.

Older Young Adults (28+ years old):

This group of 28 to 30 that meets every Saturday consists mostly of those who are working and are already committed to Christ and serving in the ministries of our congregation. Some are married. We have time to refresh our souls with the Word of God and also discuss their struggles in the workplace and in families. On August 7, we had a joint meeting with another church via Zoom and dealt with the subject of: ANXIETY IN TIMES OF PANDEMIC. We concluded by sharing the Gospel.



School:

Because of the winter holidays, we have not had school the last two weeks. Monday we resumed classes, in addition to courses and teachings.

Biblical Preaching/Teaching at La Roca Christian Church:

Both Tuesdays and Thursdays and even some Sundays, we preach and teach the Word of God with the purpose of helping Pastor Juan Barrientos in his responsibilities at La Roca Christian Church ("La Roca").



Our Tuesday Zoom group includes about 80 families who are studying First Corinthians. Even in times of pandemic, these families have responded with faithfulness. At the end of each study, we conclude by sharing the Gospel with new people invited by our congregation.

Our Thursday Zoom group includes about 75, and we preach on the parables in the Luke.

And on Sundays, La Roca has experienced growth in attendance since we have been able to meet again as a church family. We have continued to notice by the Grace of God a great commitment by those attending church for the person of Christ and His

Truth. Attendance continues to grow despite the pandemic and how difficult life is in Peru. In person, there are about 220 attendees and virtually there are about 55. We give glory to God for this increase!

As a family:

We have had time to go out with our children to have a time of recreation and vacation for two weeks. This is thanks to vehicle that God has provided us through you, dear brothers. Without neglecting our service and commitment to God, we enjoyed this family vacation along with David and Nathan. We are very grateful for the encouragement we received during vacation to continue serving God. We are moved to serve in the best possible way with greater commitment and honor to Our Lord.
