






Andres & Monica Acosta Córdoba, Argentina: October 2021

These teachings have gone out digitally and also in small groups via WhatsApp. As far as my health goes, I am doing well. God has kept me healthy so I can focus more on helping Monica stay healthy. I have also been able to be involved in the ministries of counseling, discipleship and evangelism. I am so amazed at what God is doing. We have seen many come to salvation and spiritual maturity through discipleship. Many brothers and sisters have stood up and continued moving forward growing in the Lord. I am grateful to God because I realize only He can do this great work.

We are slowly restarting the work in northern Cordoba. The pandemic has really limited us there. We spent about a 18 months without being able to go, and so many there have been affected and afraid of getting Covid19.
