Lima, October 4, 2021

Beloved,

We want to share with you how our Great God has helped and blessed us. On July 6, 2021 we held our first church service again after one year and 4 months. The laws in our country were very strict. That day 100 people gather together at the church and many on Zoom to worship God and to praise Him for His goodness on our lives, for His protection during this time of pandemic. To this date October 4, 2021 our attendance has grown to 200 plus including children, and we have another connected through Zoom because of health issues, age, and fears. We see new believers with a great desire to grow in the knowledge of God and making good decisions for the glory of God, but also, we see others deciding to live in sin and not taking good decisions to honor our Lord Jesus Christ.

From September 11 through 20 we have received a medical group of 33 people who gave medical, ear and eye care, medicines, glasses and some clothing. We went to 5 different places around José Galvez, and the group saw 1134 people and we were able to share the gospel to each of them. We went to a new area, Roldan, Cañete, about one-and-a-half-hour South of Lima. We continue to visit this place to do follow up, and on September 24 we saw



the first lady trusting Jesus as her Savior, her name is Yamilith. This day La Roca 3 – Roldan started and we praise God for this new daughter church. A family of our church has a property in that area, and is opening their place for us to start a new church plant in this area, and on October 1 we went with 3 families of our church, and we were able to start a Bible Study with 3 new persons that came, and yes, including Yamilith. What a joy we all had seeing this happening in this time. We want to thank

God for this group and just to see how God used them to start a church in Roldan fills our hearts with joy. God provided 48 Bibles, chairs and some tables for the start of this church. Please, pray that this families will continue with this same enthusiasm and that more will involve to help with the work of evangelism and discipleship.
