Working for God in Honduras

Dear friends,

It is our pleasure to share with you the details about our ministry work. First, I want to thank God for allowing me to serve Him for the advancement of His kingdom. Second, I want to thank each of you for your invaluable partnership through prayer and financial support, both of which allow this ministry to function.



I want to begin by sharing that despite the difficulties of the pandemic and the government corruption in Honduras, God continues working in the hearts of the people. God has allowed us to open the nutrition center again, and we continue to give 35 children two meals a week in the community of Balibrea. Please pray that the Lord will continue to provide for this ministry, as we only have food through next January.



We also want to inform you that next February, the schools will reopen. This means that we will give the children academic scholarships again. We ask that you pray that God would provide the money needed to fully fund all of the academic scholarships for the children.

After several years of training the leaders at the church in Balibrea, there is now a new pastor. He is doing a great job, the church continues to grow, and we are continuing to train more leaders to take the Gospel to other nearby communities.

Soon, we will begin a literacy class in Balibrea for adults and youth that have not yet learned to read or write for different reasons. Please pray that God will provide the materials needed to teach these people and that He will allow us to share the Gospel with them.

Having leaders that are doing a good job has allowed us to reach other communities with the Gospel.



We are also working with the Paso Hondo community in Siguatepeque. This year, we were able to help 120 children with academic scholarships, and we have also been able to construct outhouses, roofs, and floors for several families living in extreme poverty. We have also taken food to people in extreme poverty in both Balibrea and Paso Hondo. Please pray that the Lord provides the necessary funds to continue helping this community.

We are also helping 4 special needs children so that they can study in a school that accommodates for all of their needs. Please continue to pray that we will continue to be able to help these children and also help more special needs children.

This year, we have offered the World Reach Bible Institute in new communities, and we have new students from other parts of Honduras. There are people who will walk two to three hours with children on their back to be able to receive the training that World Reach is offering.



The leaders of our church, Christian Family Center, myself included, are preparing to visit two new places: Guascotoro and El Duraznal, which are both located in the district of La Paz, Honduras. We hope to evangelize the people living in this community and train new brothers and sisters in Christ.

Please share this letter with your church and friends so that they can pray persistently for us. I know this letter will reach you around Christmas, and for that reason Reina and I wish you a Merry Christmas and a prosperous 2022!
