A Year of Storms



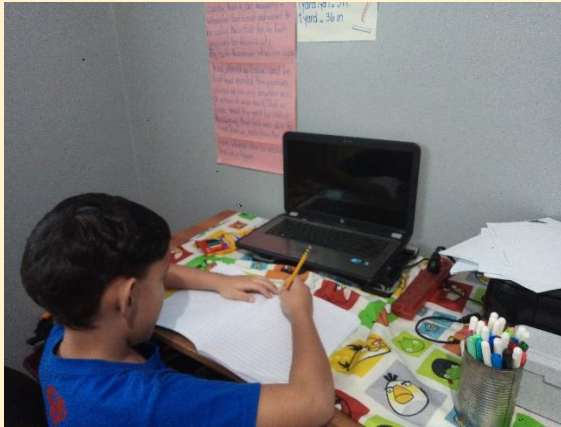
Last year, our country suffered the effects of the hurricanes Eta and Lota. There were
