2021 in Review: Bobby and Lolly Wilson

Travel: I made three trips to Colombia and one to Peru.

SD card School for leaders: 400 SD cards were distributed in Honduras, Peru, and Colombia. The cards contained about six months of Biblical studies with PDF files and videos.

Zoom meetings: Over the year I have had over 160 meetings with pastors, churches, leaders, and team members.

Bible Institute Curriculum: I proposed changes in 2020 that led to developing a new and improved Bible Institute curricula and format. The development team has members from five countries, and we are creating the new preliminary classes and first-year courses now for our 2022 relaunch.

Education: I was able to complete certificates in Church Consultation and Church Revitalization.

Simon got married! I was blessed to attend and help officiate Simon and Laura's wedding in Rio Negro, Colombia. We have worked together for many years.

How can I make sure my ministry outlives me? Recruit young leaders! I praise the Lord that we have added three members to the team in Colombia this year! They are the future for World Reach in Colombia.

Anderson joins our World Reach Colombia Team to advance the Bible Institutes (BI), to teach pastors and aspiring pastors through the BI, and to serve as a mentor to BI students and maintain relationships with graduates. Anderson will provide missions training and assist with strategy development for churches in Colombia. He will also develop strategies to engage and train young people for ministry.

2022 promises to be exciting as the work on the new Bible Institute curricula will (Lord willing) go live and in person!
