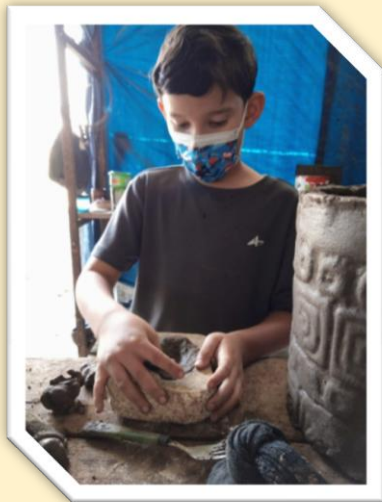
Alisson's Challenges
