Knives and Kids Ministry Don't Mix

At the end of December we had the opportunity to hold a very special Christmas celebration with the Kids' Club in Bosa. We had one of the biggest turnouts of the year as our regular attendees invited their neighborhood friends to share in the festivities.

This time was full of laughter, joy, games, treats, and a wonderful time in God's Word. However, this joy quickly turned to fear as one of the older (14 year-old) boys who was invited for his second time got upset with Franklin for cutting in line during one of the games. He pulled out a large knife threatening Franklin. Praise God, we were able to intervene and nobody got hurt.

Franklin was one of the first boys that we met at the beginning of the pandemic. He was soft spoken and eager to learn from God's Word. He grew so much in his understanding of who God is as he faithfully completed his Bible study packet EVERY week. However, once we started in person Kids Club in September 2021, Franklin stopped attending and we lost contact with him. The Christmas party was the first time we had seen him since September, and his demeanor had changed drastically. Franklin has some new friends who are not a good influence and he has begun struggling with anger and trying to fit in with the wrong crowd.

Please pray for Franklin, and for each of these kids and youth as they are faced with the daily decision to choose to walk with Christ or to give in to living like those that are in the world. The neighborhood where we are planting the church and hosting kids club has a huge problem with drugs and gang influence. Our heart is to reach the kids with the Gospel so that they will have the tools they need to resist the temptations they face on a daily basis.

We hope that Franklin and each of these kids "may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge— that [they] may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God."
