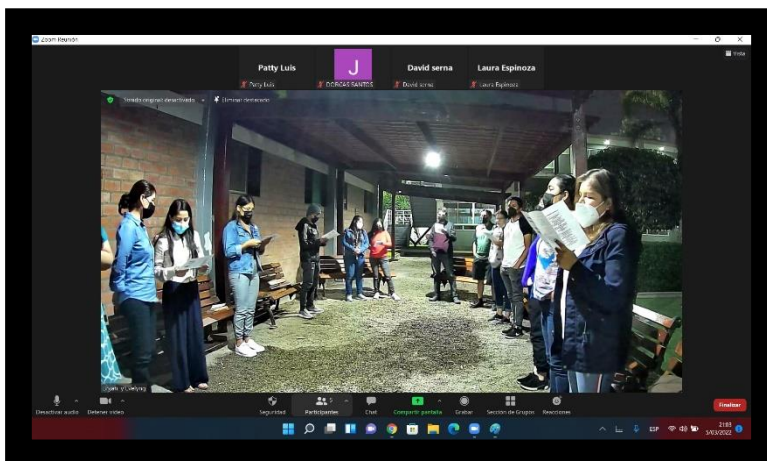
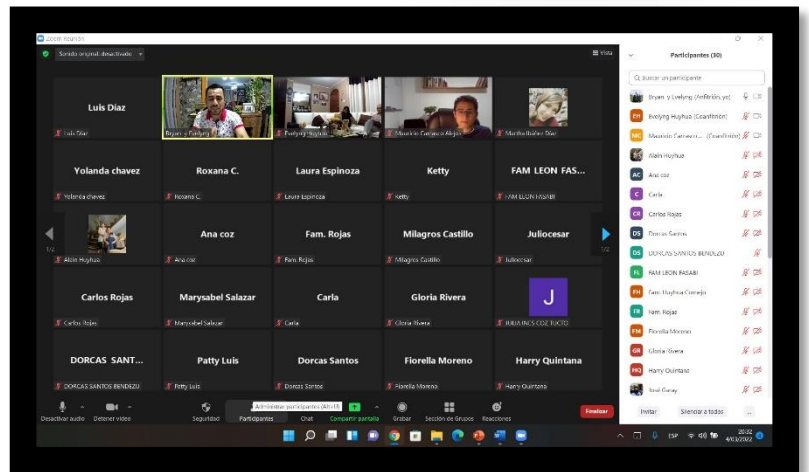
January to March 2022

they can remain faithful and strong in The Rock, Jesus Christ.



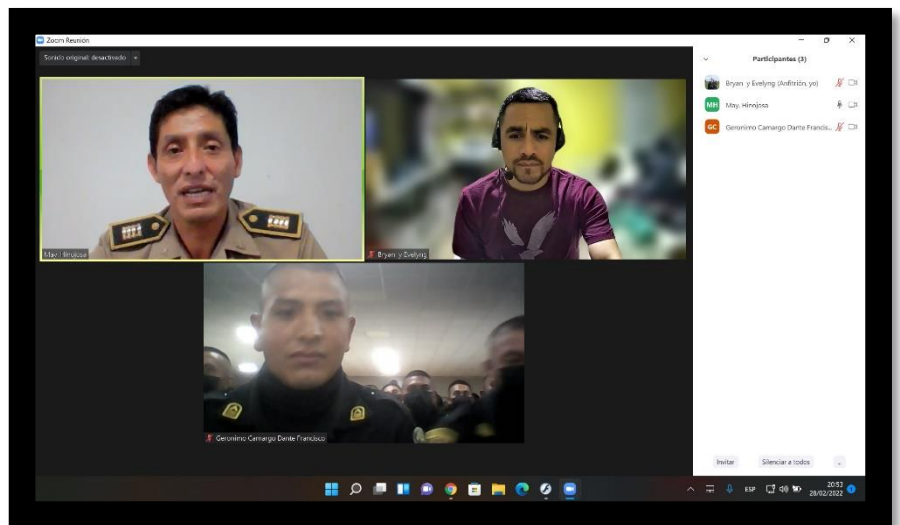
Furthermore, the youth ministry: teenagers, young, and young adults, have grown in number, but

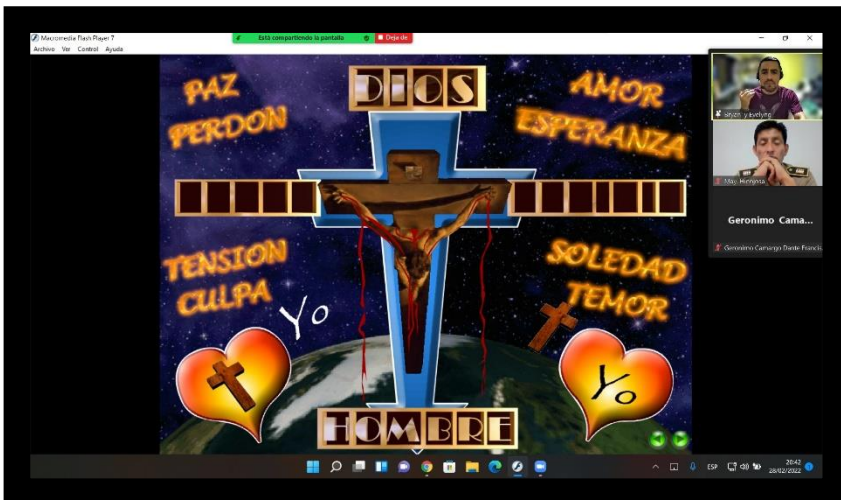

Within this group of different families and young people, we see God's graceful hand bringing to his feet people that are hungry and thirsty of His Word.

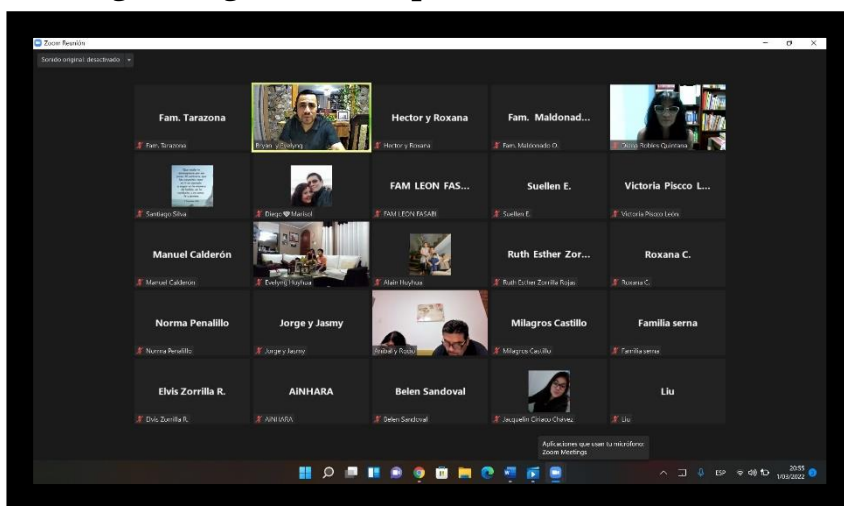

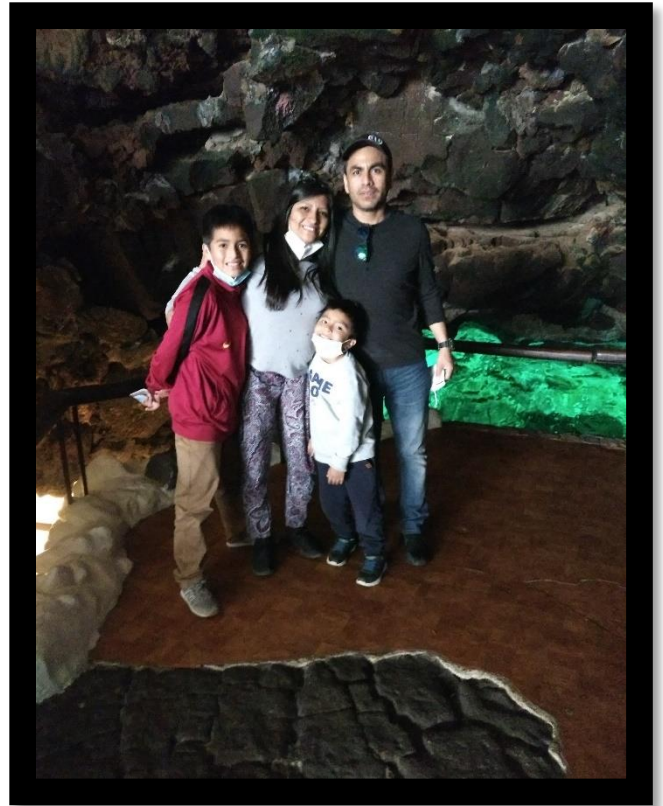
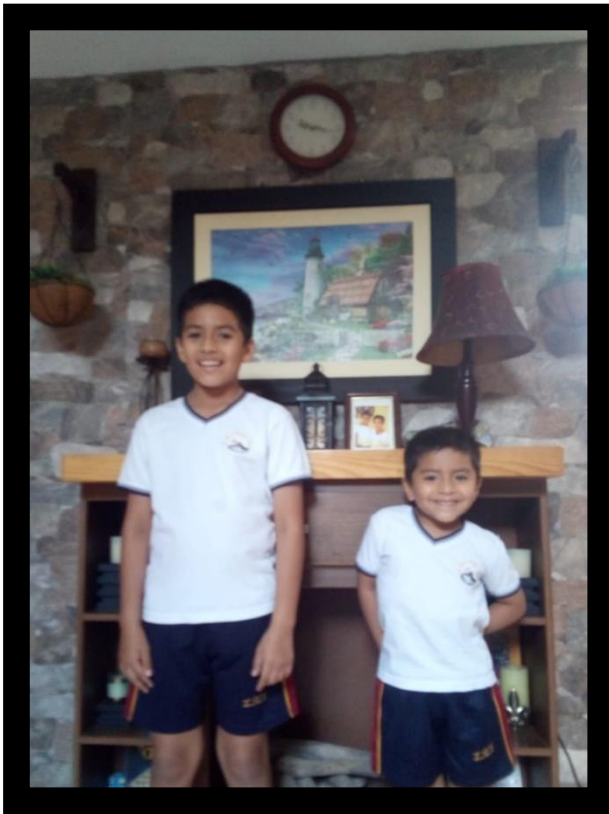
