In January I gathered with our Colombian team for a staff retreat. This was their first in-person gathering since covid. We had an opportunity to pray, study the word, review some of Dr. Blackaby's book on *Spiritual leadership*, and plan the next Bible Institute class. We have met regularly on zoom, but meeting face to face over four days was a refreshing change. The team took turns cooking and doing dishes. Relationships were deepened and the team has great opportunities ahead.

We need a place to film upcoming courses and develop the audio and video needed for online and inperson Bible Institute courses. Today I spoke to Andrew, our missionary team member who lives in northern Ukraine. He was very encouraged by God's protection and from the fruit of his ministry during the crisis. He has been distributing eggs, chickens, and flour with the gospel. His city has been bombed, but not as severely as many others. God has protected them, and the believers have been able to gather for church services. Near his city, some believers have even fed and spoken to some young hungry Russian soldiers. Some quit the battle and tried to return home, but sadly, reportedly they were executed at the border. Pray for peace in Ukraine and the gospel to be proclaimed.
