World Reach is also in contact with him, getting reports about the status of their welfare there. They are still meeting for church, which is a blessing. We are so encouraged by his faith in the midst of uncertainty and turmoil.

I am still teaching Sunday School. I just finished the Book of Genesis and now I am teaching the Book of Exodus. This book parallels with our Exodus out of sin through the Lord Jesus Christ. I am excited to see what we will all learn. I am scheduled to go to Kenya this June to teach the last World Reach Bible Institute course which is on Evangelism to the Pastors before graduation.
