



Bombs / Bullets / Water

I want to give you an update regarding a couple of situations that are impacting lives in a world that is fallen and broken.

First, Ukraine, a country at war. World Reach staff Andrew and Luba Bulyhin live in Sumy, a city in northeastern Ukraine, very close to the Russian border. They have experienced shelling and Russian troop movements through their city. At the beginning of the war, they decided to remain in Sumy to help members of their church and others cope with the situation.



Their church has served as a food distribution center and Andrew and Luba have been helping get food to those in need in and around Sumy.

In one conversation that I had with Andrew, he said they are often asked a question, especially by those who do not know Christ— “How could your good God allow this to happen?” This is an understandable question... How would you answer it in the middle of bombs and bullets?

Please pray for safety for the Bulyhins and continued opportunities to be salt, light, and the aroma of Christ to those who are in need of the Savior.

The second situation involves water at our World Reach medical clinic in Muthetheni, Kenya. We will soon begin drilling a much needed well to supplement our dependence on rain water, which is often sparse. The need is great, for without a reliable water supply, there can be no clinic. The well will most likely need to be deep, around 700 feet. The clinic not only meets physical needs, but through our staff, spiritual needs. As many as 400 people per month have been visiting our clinic.

Pray that God will bless us with a reliable water source; so we can continue to share about Jesus, who is The Water of Life!

Thank you so much for your prayer and/or financial support for the Cause of Christ around the world through World Reach. I'll have another teaching assignment in Kenya this summer.
