### Teaching at Camps in Bogota, Colombia:

We had a great time teaching the Word of God.

It was a time in which the Word was highly valued by this gentle group who studied and accepted the Word on each topic I addressed. We thank God for the attitude of the campers and the leaders, and for the eagerness of every participant to serve the Lord during that week.

After the week of camp, I had the opportunity to visit brothers of the church in Bogota, sharing the Word of

God with their families and anyone else who would listen. This filled us with joy and spurred us on to continue sowing the Word of God with these people.
