One of the highlights of our trip was the opportunity that Fany and most of the kids had to see snow for the first time. Marissa and Jayden had seen snow before, but Jayden was too young to remember. We had much fun sledding, building snowmen and throwing snowballs. They even had the fantastic experience of "skating" in their boots on a small, frozen pond near my mom's house.

While on our trip, we were able to visit our four partner churches in southern Michigan. And we were able to meet with pastor friends from our partnering churches in Augusta, Georgia. We are grateful for so many who continue to serve alongside us while we live and minister in Honduras. We are humbled and honored to collaborate with you in this way.















On February 12th we returned to Honduras and on the 20th of February we met together with the rest of the World Reach-Honduras team to lay down plans for this year's ministry projects. One of those projects is the construction of an office building for our team. This structure will be built on the property of one of our mission's church plants. It will not only house space for overseeing the logistics of our mission in Honduras but will also provide spaces for training church leaders and ministering to the needs of the immediate community around the church facilities.

We plan to build a special classroom which will allow us to teach a small group of students and double as a small studio for creating video and audio content for our training endeavors. Additionally, the

structure will contain a small medical and dental clinic which will minister to the needs of the community.

To finance part of this project, we are in the process of selling a property closer to the center of town. Our mission bought it in 2001 and it has appreciated significantly in value. The proceeds from the sale of that property will be the main source of finances for this project. However, construction materials continue to increase in cost so we are trusting that God will provide for what is needed to complete this project. Please join us in praying that this building may be useful for reaching the people in the immediate community and ministering to those around the world.
