Our pastoral students in Meru

Dear Family and Friends,

I really enjoyed teaching 17 Kenyan pastors in my course on Discipleship and Spiritual Leadership from March 18-27 at our Bible Institute (BI) in Meru, Kenya. God blessed the course tremendously and the students worked hard and learned a lot. They are taking the Pastoral Care course from May 9-13 and will take Evangelism June 6-10, and they'll graduate on June 11! They've done well and will complete 18 courses since starting their program in 2018.

In my position as Kenya Bible Institute Coordinator, I'm excited that we'll begin training our sixth group of Kenyan pastors and church leaders in Sept. By March, we'll be teaching courses in two locations: Meru and Muthethini. We have a medical clinic in Muthethini and are building a dormitory with a meeting hall for classes so that we can open a new Bible Institute there to train pastors. God is good!

Since teaching my course in Meru, I've been working hard on writing two new courses for our Bible Institutes in Latin America: Hermeneutics and Personal Spiritual Life. I'm on two teams working on these courses. We're excited that live BI classes are beginning again in Peru, Colombia and Honduras after the Covid pandemic which limited us to Zoom & online classes only.
