I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work that you gave me to do.

John 17:4 -

This verse has been embedded in my mind recently. Jesus' words in this magnificent prayer reveal how clear His priorities were during His days on earth. Jesus had glorified the Father not by accomplishing the work God gave to John the Baptist, or Mary, or any of the 12, not by accomplishing the work others thought He should accomplish, but by accomplishing the work God had specifically given Him.

I wonder... have our hours, days, weeks, months, and years been used to fulfill the work He has specifically given us? God has provided all the resources to make it happen, but have we used them wisely or have we been distracted by using them for our own purposes? God help us and as Jonathan Edwards said, "seal in our eyelids eternity" to stay focused on what really matters: His glory, which is what we were created for.

From February to May, God has been working in different places and I have had the wonderful opportunity to join Him. I will share with you some of the highlights, and I'm grateful for your willingness to read this letter.

Teaching, Evangelism, and Discipleship o o o

AGAP, the foundation where I have been teaching the Bible to women and teens, held a health and evangelism day. I oversaw the evangelism section for 50-60 children 8-12 years old.

I don't think I have ever repeated the gospel message as many times. It was incredibly uplifting for me to be reminded of Jesus' sacrifice. I long for the Holy Spirit to work in the hearts of these little ones. Many showed an understanding that because of their sinful condition they were alienated from God and of Jesus' role in our reconciliation with God. Amazing!

This generation is being bombarded with hundreds of ideals that bring confusion into their lives, so the best way to love our little ones is to bring them the light, clarity and freedom that only the

Gospel offers. Let us pray for this generation!

I was invited by a group of women to teach two lessons on Priorities and Circumstances from the book, Lies Women Believe: And the Truth that Sets Them Free. Pray for Gisella. She genuinely shared her questions, and opinions, but at the same time was willing to receive the truths of God's word.

God also gave me the opportunity to attend an in-depth Biblical counseling conference on the topic of finances with Jim Newheiser as one of the teachers.
