WATER AND MEDICAL - MUTHETHENI CLINIC

I've just returned from Kenya ministering at our two mission stations, Muthetheni and Meru. For years we have operated a clinic in Muthetheni and are in the process of upgrading/enhancing medical services we provide this impoverished community. Water is essential for any clinic and its always been a challenge for us in this very dry community. These future enhancements will create an even greater demand for water!

Pics below - Four medical officers (along with a few of our staff) were invited to our campus to be sure we are in Clinic compliance, Muthetheni staff, Rueben, our Chief Nurse at the clinic, tasting the water from our new well (557' deep). This water is consumable and will not need to be treated!! It pumps at an approximate rate of 4,000 liters an hour which is upwards of 1,000 gallons...providing all the present and future water needs to serve the ministries located on this campus!! Prayer before drilling, preaching in local churches and an open air evangelistic crusade in the local market, not pictured!

Ministries included on this campus are; our clinic, soon to be a new BI site with a full dormitory to host all the students (more info soon on this initiative), Biblical lessons provided to all the students in local schools and with our new well be able to provide much needed water to the community, etc.















As noted above, **Physical Water - Spiritual Water -** Now, to the medical component of our trip. Most of the trip was devoted to identifying and pricing medical equipment for the clinic upgrade. **After visiting three Medical Suppliers in Nairobi, trying to analyze the medical officers recommendations/requirements for the upgrades, addressing a myriad of other governmental requirements all while filling for a "Tax-Exempt" status, we continue this journey!!** 

Please pray with us on the clinic upgrade requirements because the Government Medical Officers seem so caught up in bureaucracy (some of what they are requiring is understandable) and perhaps see this as a Missionary Organization with lots of money. They are requiring an enormous number of new hires, etc, etc!! Please pray these are relaxed or certainly reduced!!

Below are a few pics of the equipment we identified and priced for upgrading the clinic. Rueben, Bobby and myself in different showrooms looking at various options and negotiating prices. The medical industry in Kenya is very competitive, perhaps the same around the globe!!









On the 24th of May, next Tuesday, Bobby Wilson (In training to ultimately replace me) travels with me to Romania, Macedonia and Albania for 12 days of ministry.
