Beloved, every opportunity that God gives us to share with you God's good hand upon our lives and how God is blessing us in our ministry and family is always a pleasure.

This year, after the crisis of the pandemic, has been without a doubt a great challenge. God has allowed us to progressively reopen each ministry face to face, and this gives us much joy.

As of now, all of our church's ministries are once again physically open, and we see God's blessing on the ministry as new families have been attending, hearing the Gospel, and are being discipled.

As for the youth, they are not only growing in number but also in their relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. We can say that they are dedicated not only to serving the Lord but also to studying His Word each Saturday, in the teen, youth, and college/career groups.





One of our great challenges was to consolidate each group with godly, stable couples who would help us to pastor each group. We can say that God has answered our prayers, since we now have two families in each of the three groups supervising and serving God, in addition to the other leaders who support them. It is a

pleasure to serve our good God alongside them; they are faithful and godly families and have demonstrated through their service a heart for God and for His work. Some of them are struggling with health problems, but even so, they continue serving faithfully. We give glory to God for these families.

In the family groups we have each Friday, this year, we had the goal of strengthening new families in our church. We began with baptism in February, where many of the new families were baptized; now each Friday we are strengthening them doctrinally. We are also seeing them start to serve God (most of them). Some of them are not yet serving, but the goal is that all these new families will be involved in serving our God.

Evelyn and some of the ladies from church have been involved in meeting each month with the single ladies. These meetings started with the goal of preparing them to be godly wives in the Lord's will. They are also learning how to set good priorities both in home and ministry while they enjoy their youth and season of singleness and to see this time as an opportunity to love God (Ecclesiastes 12:2). They have been attending quite regularly with hearts eager to learn. They still have one last meeting this year, which they are preparing for now. We give thanks to God because through this ministry we are able to give them solid principles for a godly life worthy of the Lord Jesus Christ and to prepare them to create homes that honor God.

Teaching Trips:

God has allowed us to fulfill the goals we had of teaching His Word and training the next generation of leaders, not only in our country but also in other countries. Each trip has truly been all we hoped for, seeing the hunger that the brothers have to learn, not only in

Peru but also in the other countries where God sent us. Our goal for 2023 is that God would allow us to continue ministering His Word with this same goal of teaching faithful men who will teach others (2 Timothy 2:2). Because, brothers, this is the area where we most serve and where we most see ourselves continuing to serve together while God continues giving us life - training those who will train others. For the moment I am doing this alone, without my wife, but we hope in God that she and my sons will be able to accompany me on some trips as God allows so that they too can be part of the work God is calling us to do.



My prayer is that God would continue allowing us to do this; it is a ministry we enjoy greatly and one where we feel useful in the hands of God and see His fruit in our ministry.

Evangelistic outings:

We are planning an outing to a new church plant God has established through our main church, and our desire is to be part of this along with our youth group. We are preparing an evangelistic drama with them, and afterwards we will share the Gospel. If God allows, this will be on December 10th. We are taking advantage of the holiday season to present Christ's coming to earth, His death, and resurrection; we hope God will give us the opportunity to share the Good News with many people.



Teaching:

Our head pastor is traveling to the United States and we will be in charge of the church for these next 6 months, alongside our team of elders, deacons, and ministry leaders. As you can see, brothers, this is a great responsibility. We pray we will be a blessing to our church and to the brothers with whom we serve.

A little while ago I fractured my ankle and had to have an operation. I am home now resting and recovering. Waiting on the recovery is hard, but God will use this time to teach my heart. We have been praying that God would grow us in grace and we believe that this will be the means He uses to strengthen our inner man. God knows that our heart is dedicated to Him, but even though this was an unexpected setback, we continue to see His **SOVEREIGN GRACE IN EACH DETAIL**. We desire to visit the States (if God wills) at the end of February 2023, to share time with each of you. But we pray that God will provide and give us direction for this trip that we would like to make as a family.



We have had invitations from two churches for this, but we are awaiting my recovery and God's timing if it is His will that we would be able to see you again and for you to meet our sons.

Even with this setback to our health, we want to continue giving Him glory with right hearts, and we pray the same for you as well. As we look towards the end of the year, we remember His coming and how it changed not only the world but also our lives and our eternity, and we eagerly await His second coming.
