Greetings from Honduras,

Part of our mission's strategy to reach the world through the local church is focused on the training of pastors and church leaders. Currently missionaries from Peru, Colombia, Honduras and the United States are working together to create a curriculum for training pastors and church leaders. This curriculum is a reformatting of the training that World Reach missionaries have provided to pastors throughout Latin America over the past two decades. It is our desire to create a curriculum which will be more effective at training and transforming those people who have a call from God to serve in a local church. Please come alongside with us and invest time in prayer asking God to bless us with wisdom and creativity as we work on finishing the classes for the first two years of this 4-year program.

Peter is finishing the lessons assigned to him for a class in Hermeneutics. Then he will begin the long

process of editing all the videos which will be included with the 8 classes.

In family news, in June, we experienced some difficulties with our health. All 6 of us had COVID. Fortunately, our symptoms were minor and we were able to recover within a week or two.

Peter had surgery to remove 4 tophi caused by gout. He has been recovering well. However, the surgery has left the middle finger on his right hand with limited range of movement. After a couple sessions of physical therapy there appears to be a little improvement. But he still is unable to type or use the computer mouse as normal. Please pray for a full recovery.

While the surgery removed some unsightly lumps, there still is the challenge of controlling the levels of uric acid in Peter's body. In the past, the go-to treatments have been ineffective. Please pray for wisdom and healing in this matter. In July, Peter and Fany travelled to Rionegro, Colombia to meet with World Reach missionaries and staff for a week of conferences. The focus of the teaching and activities was "How to find rest in the ministry." We are grateful and encouraged to see how World Reach continues to invest in the longevity of their missionaries.

The conference speakers were World Reach missionaries to Romania and counselors, Francisco and Martha Berrios and missions pastors Bryan Wintersteen (Briarwood Presbyterian) and Gary Kennedy (Shades Mountain Community).





This past May, our World Reach team was invited by Pastor Jesus Corea to begin our School for Leaders curriculum with a group of pastors and church leaders. Pastor Corea ministers in El Duraznal, a village in the Guajiquiro Biological Reserve. It is a mountainous region populated primarily by the Lenca, the largest indigenous group in Honduras. Pastor Corea has a vision for strengthening his church and planting several churches throughout this region. Please pray for the students and the World Reach team as we invest our efforts in their spiritual growth.
