Our goals and prayers for 2023 are as follows:



1. We have been invited to go to the jungle in April and September. The purpose is to celebrate the 75th anniversary of Iglesias Bíblicas Unidas. In the month of April we would be with the Curipacos tribe. This

is the first tribe Sophie Muller had contact with. This is the tribe where the first church was planted, and it reached the other tribes:

Puinaves, Piapocos, Guajhibos and Cubeos. For the trip in September we would be with the Puinaves tribe. This tribe is near two rivers. One is in the jungle of Venezuela, the other is in the jungle of Colombia. The plans have been set in motion and coordinated, and we have been in-



vited. We only ask God to guide and provide. One purpose is to research the life of Sophie Mueller. Monica and Melissa have been writing a book about her life for the last 10 years. We want to ask you to pray with us as we prepare for this. The greatest cost will be the plane tickets from Argentina to Colombia, then into the jungle where the conference will take place. We will incur a similar cost when we fly out in September. The majority of the youth that



studied with us when we were in the jungle are pastors, missionaries and leaders. It is beautiful to see what God is doing. From these former students, 19 churches have been planted. Today, their children need to be trained and prepared to conti-
