



## Huyhua Family in Lima, Peru January - March Update

Dear brothers and sisters,

I write to you greatly encouraged, as we have seen the hand of our good God during this time in our lives and ministry.

As you may know, we have now finished an intense time of ministry activities including evangelistic medical campaigns and summer camps. We are now returning to our normal activities with the church and mission.



Evangelism: Even with the intense heat of the

summer, we were very pleased with the activities that we were able to do with the brothers and sisters who came from the USA with medical doctors and other health professionals. They offered their services free of charge in the different places that we had the opportunities to go to. Together with them, we presented the gospel to each individual that God allowed to come and receive medical attention. We went to 12 different places and in each place 200 to 280 people gathered. We had tremendous opportunities to present Christ as Savior and Lord. We experienced the Lord's strength even in the midst of becoming tired as the week went on. It was then that His grace was sufficient, and we could carry out the real purpose of evangelism.

It was very pleasing to see various young people who have graduated from our school and who are from our church, participating and serving in the areas of translation and evangelism. Our sons, David and Nathan, also had the opportunity to go to each place with us, including a new place two hours from the capital where God has permitted our church to begin a





new church plant within the last two years. Our sons learned little by little how to serve our God. This is not only a reason to rejoice, but also to praise God.

**Camps:** After two years of the pandemic, we were able to return to our customary summer camps the beginning of this year. We had three weeks of camp. We began with middle school kids, then we had high

school kids, and we ended with elementary kids. Due to the continued recovery process from my ankle surgery, the young people who God allowed us to train were our hands and

feet to carry out the tasks as they served in these activities. It was a blessing to see them serve and take responsibility for each detail. It is satisfying to see their hearts committed to God. Each week we had around 78 campers, in addition to the 40 staff who helped serve.



The second week, Evelyng had to delegate her camp kitchen responsibilities to faithful sisters from church, as she was gone on Wednesday of that week due to a biopsy that she needed to have done. So far, the doctors have given us positive reports, but we are still awaiting the final results. Several brothers and youth looked after our sons as they were unable to accompany us to the clinic. Even in these details we saw God's care and how good He really is!



## Invitations to teach at other

churches: Filadelfia Church invited us to their 45<sup>th</sup> anniversary conference to share God's Word. For 3 days, we were able to go and complete our goal of communicating the importance of training the next generation and passing on the responsibility to new leadership. The church responded well as they listened to God's Word and committed to serve and follow Christ.



We were also invited to share God's

Word with married couples at "Nuevo Amanecer" church in Manchay, an hour and a half from here. They invited us to be with married couples and families to share about priorities in the

home, our relationship with Christ, and the seriousness and primary responsibility as parents of raising our children.

Interviews with parents who are applying to La Roca Christian School: We began this stage as usual in October of 2022 and we have continued through February interviewing parents who desire to enroll their children in our school. As they go through the application process, I have the opportunity to not only interview them, but also to share with them the principles, foundations, and vision of the school. This allows me to end by sharing Christ with them. It's an exhausting but rewarding experience to converse with them and to have the opportunity to present the gospel as well.

**Our family:** As you can see, dear brothers and sisters, our summer has been quite busy. However, we do not want to neglect our family that God in his grace has given us. Even though our kids are happy with all the activities, we desire to spend time with them also. Because of this, we would ask you to pray for this daily necessity that we have as parents. Please also pray for Evelyng, as she continues to deal with an infection in her breast. She is receiving treatment, and at times she is bothered by pain. But we thank God because the oncology reports have been good so far and the results have not been cancerous. This is a tremendous reason to praise our good God!

Brothers and sisters, we have had the desire to visit you all. But as I have shared, I had surgery done on my ankle in November 2022. God has been healing me quicker than I thought. I didn't think that I was going to be able to participate actively this summer, but it didn't turn out that way. God gave me the privilege to direct the camps and to go out with our church to evangelize.

Additionally, with this problem that Evelyng is dealing with, God hasn't allowed us to go and share with you in person for now. We continue to pray and thank God for your prayers and goodness with which you give and help us. May God remember your prayers, love, and offerings that you have shared with us (Psalm 20:1-4).

God has been testing us, and not only us, but other families who faithfully help us. They also have been going through times of testing with health problems. But they continue to be faithful and an example to follow with their dedication to serve our Lord Jesus Christ, despite their physical limitations and conditions. They have a great impact and testimony.

We continue to see the grace of our good God in details like these, and it is one of the reasons we share with you so that you may also join us in worshiping God.
