We now have 16 children in Secondary school (boarding school), which is like U.S. grades 9-12. We have another 6 children living on our campus full-time and attending local Primary school.

We're pleased that Victor and Ronny graduated Secondary school at year's end and both desire a higher form of education to become self-sustaining citizens of Kenya. Their grades qualify them for more schooling should the Lord provide the needed funds.



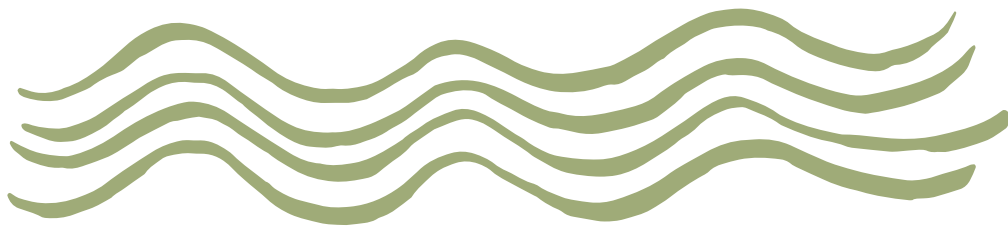

The medical clinic is growing and needs Ken's skills, and we are so very thankful that the Lord led Ken to our clinic rather than pursuing a more financially lucrative position elsewhere!

Greetings to you, Brothers & Sisters!

Let me update you about the Orphanage in Kenya. First of all, I want to thank God and the entire donors for supporting us in 2022.



The Lord is still faithful to our orphanage children even in the year 2023. We as World Reach are praying God's blessings upon your life. We also need a lot of prayers because in Kenya now we are experiencing a serious drought in many parts of the country. It has not rained for 2 years!



God has given us an opportunity to add 3 new children in our orphanage this year namely Jeff, Utycus and Ibrahim. Utycus and Jeff are 12 years old and Ibrahim is 14 years old. Jeff is in Primary school while Utycus is in Junior Secondary school, a new system of education which started in January 2023.

Ibrahim is in his first year of Secondary School. Because he did very well in his examinations after Primary school and got good grades, he was able to join a very good Secondary school.

These new children are very happy and thanking God for World Reach having taken them in to provide shelter, food, education, physical/medical care, spiritual guidance, and nourishment. Therefore, please continue to pray for us so that God will open more doors for financial support so that these children will complete their education and good care.

I would like also to tell you the good news of another former orphan, Ken Mwitii. You can remember me telling you about Ken who has completed his medical school training and did very well and was awarded a nursing license by the government of Kenya to work. Ken felt he wanted to come back and work full-time in our World Reach Medical Clinic in Muthetheni as a clinical officer, who is next to a doctor. We thank God for Ken for his great calling in working as full-time staff, which is a living testimony to the community and to the world. Ken is a wonderful example to other children who are currently in school, both in his education and in his spiritual life.

We have another boy by the name Victor, who has completed and graduated from his Secondary education, and he has joined a cooking college for 2 years. Victor previously lived with his grandmother after his father died when he was too small, and God opened the way to join our orphanage. Victor will one day be a wonderful chef, cooking delicious food. Pray for Victor that God will provide his financial support so that he will be able to finish these courses well.

We have another boy by the name Ronny, who has also completed and graduated his Secondary education. He studied faithfully and did good, and we are praying that he will be able to join a teaching school this year. Therefore, pray for Ronny that God will provide funds for Ronny to attend a teaching school as he feels called to teach children in school like he was taught.



Ronny is a true orphan whose father and mother died many years ago when Ronny was too small, and he had nowhere to stay, nothing to eat and no opportunity for education until World Reach received him in our orphanage. Ronny grew in the orphanage and became a very strong Christian leader. Now Ronny enjoys preaching the Word, and he is even preaching in our church and to our orphanage children. Ronny conducts bible study groups and is active with the youth church.

My prayer brother and sisters is to continue serving with these orphanage children so that God will change their destinies and most importantly their spiritual lives.

Pray for World Reach mission whom God gave the mission and vision of reaching the unreached with the message of Jesus Christ. Pray for the staff who are taking care of the children with the love of Jesus Christ. It is a great call from God to be a part of impacting the lives of children.
